This will ensure the ministry is not bound to purchase 2,000 units, strips or numbers of the item / equipment
3	The dimensions of the equipment are defined in the tender specification section, however due to the nature of the project, the specification may vary across levels of hospitals and size of the hospitals	For certain equipment the dimensions of the equipment provided by the vendor can be greater than or equal to the ones provided in the tender specification sheet. Due to the nature of the project, the specification may vary across levels of hospitals and size of the hospitals.

4	The bidder is allowed to provide only 1 quote and vendor, which may be a limiting factor in the supply of the number of equipment required, due to the nature of the project.	The bidder is allowed to provide multiple options with alternate vendors at the same price and specifications throughout the period of the contract, so as to ensure the bidder meets the requirements in terms of the quantity and timely delivery due to the nature of the project.
5	Kindly clarify if the Quality Management Certificate (ISO) required is for the manufacturer or the tenderer. ISO certificate should be for the Equipment Manufacturer but Not for Tenderer	The Quality Management Certificate (ISO) required is for the Equipment Manufacturer
