1. This invitation follows the general procurement notice that appeared in UNDB Online reference no. WB4253-784/10 of 28th September, 2010
2. The Government of Kenya has received a Credit from the International Development Association (IDA) supporting the Kenya Health Sector Support Project (KHSSP) and intends to apply part of the funds in purchasing vehicles.
3. The Ministry of Health now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the supply and delivery of motor vehicles as detailed below;

4. Bidders may bid for any one or all items, provided they offer the full number of units required for each item. Bidders not offering the full number required for each item will be considered non-responsive. Bid evaluation will be done on a per ITEM basis. The delivery period will be from 8 to 18 weeks, both dates inclusive counted from the point in time when the supplier has received an effective L/C.
5. Bidders' qualifications requirements include: (i) Manufacturer's authorization (ii) if the bidder is not doing business within the Purchaser's country, the bidder is or will be (if awarded the contract) represented by an Agent in the country equipped and able to carry out the suppliers maintenance, repair and spare parts-stock obligations described in the conditions of contract and/or technical specifications. A margin of preference for goods manufactured domestically shall not be applied.
6. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and are open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Guidelines.
7. Interested eligible bidders may obtain more information from and inspect the tender document at the Ministry's Supply Chain Management Office situated at the **Health Sector Reform Secretariat Prefabricated Block (behind the main building, Room 6B), Afya House Cathedral Road- Nairobi**, on normal working days between **9.00 A.M. and 4.00 P.M.**
