Distribution of IEC materials	 Distribute Covid-19 IEC materials to communities Keep inventory of IEC materials received and distributed 			
Monitoring, Evaluation and Research	 Keep daily COVID-19 activity records Prepare and Submit weekly reports to CHEWs every Friday by 12 Noon
