**UPDATE OF CORONAVIRUS IN THE COUNTRY AND
RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT 15th MAY, 2020**

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Thank you for joining us today for our daily update on the status of COVID-19 in Kenya and our response to it.

In the last 24 hours, 2,100 persons have been tested and we have confirmed an

coronavirus infections, which raises the national tally to 781.

The cases are spread as follows-

Nairobi eleven **(11)**, Mombasa five **(5)**, Kajiado three **(3)**, Kiambu two **(2)** and Wajir two **(2)**.

In Nairobi County, the eleven cases are from; Embakasi **(6)**, Kamukunji **(2)**, Langata **(2)** and Starehe **(1)**. Mombasa cases are ALL from Mvita. Kiambu cases are from Thika and the two **(2)** cases in Wajir are from Wajir East Sub-County. In Kajiado, two **(2)** cases are truck drivers from Namanga Border Point, and one from Ilbisil in Kajiado Central.

In terms of disaggregation, five **(5)** are females, eighteen **(18)** males, with the age ranging between 24 years and 85 years.

Consistent with the growing number of losses we are making, over the last 24 hours we have lost three patients. Each fatality is a tragedy and we pray that the Almighty comforts their loved ones as He rests their souls in peace.
