SUMMARY OF COVID-19 STATUS IN KENYA OVER THE LAST 24 HOURS

NAIROBI, Saturday, July 11, 2020

As a follow-up to our press statement on COVID-19, this is the summary of today's statistics over the past 24 hours.

Today, we have tested **1,403** samples, out of which **278** people have tested positive for coronavirus. The cumulative number of tests conducted so far now stands at **207,787** and the total case load in the country is **9,726**

Out of the **278** positive cases **273** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners, with **166** being males, and **112** females. The youngest positive case is one-year-old child, while the oldest is **86 years**.

The new positive cases are distributed in counties as follows; Nairobi **162**, Kajiado **40**, Kiambu **28**, Machakos **22**, Nakuru **16**, Siaya **2**, Mombasa **2**, Murang'a **1**, Nyamira **1**, Meru **1**, Homa-Bay **1**, Nyandarua **1**, Uasin-Gishu **1**.

In sub-counties the cases are distributed as follows; in Nairobi, the **162** cases are in; Dagoretti North (**37**), Kibra (**21**), Langata (**18**), Embakasi East (**16**), Westlands (**12**), Starehe (**11**) , Kasarani (**8**) , Embakasi South(**7**) Embakasi Central and Embakasi West (**6**) cases each, Mathare (**5**), Kamukunji, Makadara and Roysambu (**4**) cases each, Dagoretti South(**2**), and Embakasi North (**1**)

In Kajiado, the **40** cases are in Kajiado East (**27**), Kajiado North (**9**) and Kajiado central (**4**), while in Kiambu, the **28** cases are in Limuru (**7**), Thika (**6**), Kikuyu and Ruiru (**4**) cases each, Kabete (**3**), Juja (**2**), Gatundu South and Kiambaa (**1**) case each.

In Machakos, all the **22** cases are in Athi River and in Nakuru, the **16** cases are from Naivasha (**7**) Nakuru East (**5**), Nakuru West (**2**) and Nakuru North (**1**)

In Mombasa, the **2** cases are in; Mvita (**1**) and Kisauni (**1**) case each.

In Murang'a, the case is in Maragwa, whilst the cases in Nyamira, Homa-Bay, Nyandarua, Meru and Uasin-Gishu are in Nyamira Town, Homa-Bay Town, Kinangop, North-Imenti and Turbo, respectively.

Today, we are also pleased to share with you that **99** patients have been discharged from various hospitals having recovered, bringing the overall number of recoveries to **2,832**.

Sadly, we have lost three (**3**) more patients to the disease, bringing our mortality count to **184**. Our heartfelt condolences go to the family and friends of the bereaved.
