**SUMMARY OF COVID-19 STATUS IN THE COUNTRY OVER THE
LAST 24 HOURS**

The following is the summary of COVID-19 statistics in the **past 24 hours** as of Sunday, July 12, 2020.

We have tested **7,050** samples, out of which, **379** people have tested positive for the virus. The cumulative number of tests conducted so far is now **215,037** and the total case load in the country stands at **10,105**.

Out of the positive cases **376** are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners, with **253** being males, and **126** of them female. According to age, the youngest is a **two (2)**-year old child, while the oldest is **97 years**

The **379** positive cases are distributed in counties as follows; Nairobi **209** Kiambu **49**, Busia **38**, Migori **19**, Mombasa **16**, Kajiado **12**, Uasin-Gishu **8**, Lamu **6**, Machakos and Nakuru **5** cases each, Narok, Wajir and Kisumu **2** cases each, and **one** case each in Garissa, Isiolo, Kericho, Nyamira, Nyeri and Trans-Nzoia counties.

In sub-counties the cases are distributed as follows; in Nairobi, the **209** cases are in; Kibra **(52)**, Langata **(45)**, Kamukunji **(28)**, Dagoretti North

and Makadara **(17)** cases **each**, Embakasi Central **(9)**, Embakasi East **(8)**, Westlands **(7)**, **4** cases **each** in Dagoretti South, Embakasi West, Kasarani and Roysambu, and **2** cases **each** in Ruaraka and Embakasi South. Mathare and Starehe had **1 case each**.

In Kiambu the **49** cases are in Ruiru **(16)**, Kiambu Town **(15)**, Lari **(7)**, Kikuyu **(4)**, Limuru and Thika **(2) cases each**, Gatundu South, Kabete and Kiambaa **(1) case each**. In Busia, the **38** cases are in Teso North **(18)**, Matayos **(15)** and Teso South **(5)** cases.

In Migori, the **19** cases are in; Suna East and Kuria East **(7) cases each**, Kuria West **(5)**. In Mombasa, the **16** cases are in Mvita **(9)**, Jomvu **(4)**, Nyali **(2)**, and **(1)** case in Likoni.

In Kajiado, the **12** cases are in; Kajiado East **(7)**, and Kajiado North **(3)** and Kajiado Central **(2)** cases. In Uasin-Gishu, **all (8)** cases are in Turbo.

In Lamu, **all (6)** cases are in Lamu West while in Machakos, the **5** cases are in Kathiani **(3)** and **(2)** in Athi River.

The **5** cases in Nakuru are distributed Naivasha **(4)** and **(1)** in Nakuru West while the **2** cases in Kisumu are in Muhoroni and Nyando. In Narok the **2** cases are in Narok North, **2** cases in Wajir East of Wajir County and **one case each** in Fafi, Nyamira Town, Kieni, and Kiminini sub-counties of Garissa, Nyamira, Nyeri and Trans-Nzoia Counties, respectively.

Today, we are also delighted to share the good news of **49** discharges from various hospitals, bringing the total number of recoveries to **2881**

Regrettably, we have lost one **(1)** more patient to the disease, bringing our cumulative fatality count to **185**.

I send our heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of the bereaved.
