**SUMMARY OF COVID-19 STATUS IN KENYA OVER THE LAST 24 HOURS**

Further, to our Press statement today, here is the summary of our COVID-19 segregated data over the past 24 hours.

We have tested **3,053** samples, out of which, **278** people have tested positive for the virus. The cumulative number of tests conducted so far now stands at **196,508** and the total case load in the country is **8,528**.

Out of the positive cases **266** are Kenyans while **12** are foreigners, with **194** being males, and **84** females. According to age, the youngest is a four-year child, while the oldest is **72**.

The **278** positive cases are distributed in counties as follows; Nairobi **131**, Kiambu **32**, Busia, **29**, Migori **23**, Machakos **20**, Kajiado **13**, **Taita** Taveta **8**, Vihiga **7**, Mombasa **5**, **Nakuru** **4**, Isiolo **2**, Makueni **2**, **Meru** and Kisii **one (1)** case each

In sub-counties the cases are distributed as follows; in Nairobi, the **131** cases are in; Dagoretti North (**34**), Kibra (**22**), Ruaraka (**14**), Langata (**13**), Westlands (**10**), Kasarani (**9**) Embakasi East and Embakasi South (**7**) cases each, Makadara (**5**), Embakasi West and Roysambu (**3**) cases each, Starehe (**2**), Embakasi West and Mathare one (**1**), case each.

In Kiambu the **32** cases are in Thika (**7**), Kabete, Kiambu, and Kikuyu (**5**) cases each, Kiambaa (**4**), Juja (**3**), Githunguri, Lari and Ruiru one (**1**) case each. In Busia, the **29** cases are in Teso South (**14**) Teso North (**8**) and Matayos (**7**).

In Migori, the **23** cases are in; Suna East (**12**), Kuria West (**5**), Kuria East (**4**), and Nyatike (**2**). In Machakos, the **20** cases are in Athi River (**9**), Machakos (**5**), Matungulu (**3**), Kathiani, Yatta, and Kangundo one (**1**), case each.

In Kajiado, the **13** cases are in; Loitokotok (**8**), Kajiodo East (**3**), and Kajiado North (**2**). Taita Taveta the **8** cases are in Voi. Vihiga, the (**7**) cases are in Vihiga. In Mombasa, all the (**5**) cases are in Mvita, while in Nakuru, the (**4**) cases are in Naivasha. In Makueni, the (**2**) cases are in Wote and in Isiolo, the (**2**) cases are in Isiolo Town. In Kisii one (**1**) case is in Kitutu Chache South and in Meru the one (**1**) case is in Imenti North.

Today, we are also delighted to inform you that **89** patients have been discharged from various hospitals, bringing the total number of recoveries to **2,593**.

Sadly, we have lost two **(2)** more patients to the disease, bringing our fatality count to **169**. I send our heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of the bereaved.
