**SUMMARY OF COVID-19 STATUS BY COUNTY AND SUB-COUNTIES
AS ON JULY 19, 2020**

Today's summary of COVID-19 situation in the country shows infection numbers are still rising. We continue to appeal to our people to carry on with the precautions and other containment measures we have shared with you seriously.

Today we have recorded another high of **603** positive cases from a sample size of **5, 724** tested in the last **24 hours**.

We now have **13,353** confirmed positive cases, while our cumulative sample tested has risen to **243,887**. In terms of gender **361** are males and **242** are females. Age wise, the youngest is a **7 month** old infant, while the oldest is **86 years**.

The **603** cases are distributed in counties as follows; Nairobi **441**, Kiambu **44**, Kajiado **29**, Mombasa **22**, Nakuru **17**, Kilifi **10**, Busia **7**, Machakos **6**, Kisii **6**, Makueni **5**, Muranga **3**, Nyeri **2**, Bungoma **2**, Kakamega **1**, Kericho **1**, Kisumu **1**, Kwale **1**, Lamu **1**, Narok **1**, Tharaka Nithi **1**, Garissa **1** and Uasin Gishu **1**.

In the sub-counties, in Nairobi's sub-counties lead with **441** cases in; Langata and Westlands (**43**) cases each, Dagoretti North (**38**), Starehe (**34**), Kibra and Ruaraka (**33**) cases each, Embakasi East (**28**), Makadara (**26**), Roysambu (**25**), Embakasi South, Embakasi West and Kasarani (**23**) cases each, Embakasi North (**21**), Kamukunji (**20**), Dagoretti South (**15**), Embakasi Central (**9**), and Mathare (**4**).

In Kiambu, the (**44**) cases are in; Kikuyu, Ruiru and Thika (**10**) cases each, Kabete and Kiambu Town (**4**) cases each, Juja, Kiambaa and (**2**) cases each. In Kajiado, the **29**, cases are in; Kajiado North (**16**), Kajiado Central (**9**) and Kajiado East (**4**).

In Mombasa, the **22** cases are in; Mvita (**11**), Jomvu (**4**), Changamwe (**3**), Likoni and Nyali (**2**) cases each while in Nakuru, the **17** cases are in; Naivasha (**15**) and Nakuru West (**2**).

In Kilifi, the **10** cases are in; Kilifi South (**8**) and Kilifi North (**2**). In Busia, the **7** cases are in Teso North (**5**) and Matayos and Teso South one (**1**) case each.

In Machakos, the **6** cases are in; Athi River (**5**) and Masinga (**1**), while Kisii, has (**6**) cases in Kituti Chache South.

Makueni has **5** cases in Kibwezi West (**3**) and Kibwezi East (**2**) while Muranga has **3** cases in Gatanga, Kandara and Kihara one (**1**) case each.

Nyeri has **2** cases in Nyeri Central, Bungoma has **2** cases in Kanduyi, Kakamega **1** case in Lurambi, Kericho **1** case in Ainamoi, Kisumu **1** case in Kisumu Central, Kwale **1** case in Lungalunga, Lamu **1** case in Lamu West, Narok **1** case in Narok West, Tharaka Nithi **1** in Chuka, Uasin Gishu **1** case in Kapseret and Garissa has one (**1**) case in town.

On a positive note, we are delighted to inform you that, today **682** patients have recovered from the disease. From this figure, **562** have been under home-based care, while **120** have been discharged from various hospitals, bringing the total number of recoveries so far to **5,122**.

Sadly, we have lost another **9** patients to the disease, bringing our fatality count to **234**.
