**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE  
MEASURES, AS AT SEPTEMBER 28, 2020**

**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **53** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,107** tested in the last 24 hours, bringing to **38,168** the number of confirmed positive cases in the country. Our cumulative tests are now **541,415**. From the cases, **all** are Kenyans except **3** who are foreigners. **32** are males and **21** females. The youngest is a **four-year old child**, while the oldest is **76**.

Distribution of the **cases by Counties** is as follows; Nairobi **11**, Meru **11**, Kiambu **6**, Uasin Gishu **6**, Nakuru **4**, Kajiado **3**, Garissa **2**, Busia **2**, Laikipia **2**, Machakos **2**, Makueni **1**, Embu **1**, Kisumu **1** and Kwale **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** Distribution; the **11** cases in **Nairobi**, are from Embakasi West and Lang'ata (2) cases each, Embakasi South, Kasarani, Kibra, Makadara, Roysambu, Starehe and Westlands (1) case each. In **Meru**, the **11** cases are from Igembe North (9), Imenti North and Imenti South (1) case each.

In **Kiambu**, the **6** cases are from Ruiru (3), Juja, Kiambu Town and Thika (1) case each. In **Uasin Gishu**, the **6** cases are from Ainabkoi (3), Kapseret (2) and Kesses (1).

In **Nakuru**, the **4** cases are from Naivasha (2), Nakuru East and Nakuru West (1) case each, while in **Kajiado**, the **3** cases are from Kajiado North (2) and Loitokitok (1).


The **2** cases in **Garissa**, are from Dadaab and Garissa Town (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Busia**, are all from Matayos, the **2** cases in **Laikipia**, are all from Laikipia East, and the **2** cases in **Machakos**, are all from Athi River.

The **case** in **Makueni**, is from Makueni, the **case** in **Embu**, is from Manyatta, the **case** in **Kisumu**, is from Kisumu Central and the **case** in **Kwale**, is from Matuga.



Today, **60** people have recovered from the disease, **36** from the Home-Based Care Program, while **24** have been discharged from various hospitals. Total recoveries now stand at **24, 681**.

Unfortunately, **9** patients have succumbed to the disease bringing the fatality to **700**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.
