**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE
MEASURES, AS AT DECEMBER 4, 2020**

PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **866** people have tested positive for the virus, from a sample size of **7,815** tested in the last 24 hours, bringing to **87,249** the number of confirmed positive cases in the country. The cumulative tests are now **919,411**. From the cases **828** are Kenyans while **38** are foreigners. In terms of gender **525** are males and **341** females. The youngest is a **three-month old infant**, while the oldest is **100**.

Distribution of the cases by **Counties** is as follows; Nairobi **273**, Mombasa **78**, Nakuru **73**, Kiambu **55**, Kirinyaga **49**, Nyamira **35**, Kisumu **27**, Kilifi **23**, Kajiado **23**, Uasin Gishu **21**, Nyeri **21**, Meru **19**, Kericho **18**, Busia **16**, Machakos **15**, Kisii **13**, Bomet **12**, Tana River **11**, Siaya **11**, Migori **10**, Taita Taveta **9**, Laikipia **9**, Bungoma **8**, Baringo **8**, Murang'a **4**, Embu **4**,

Homa Bay **3**, Vihiga **3**, Kitui **3**, Lamu **3**, Garissa **2**, Nandi **2**, Nyandarua **1**, Narok **1**, Wajir **1** Makueni **1**, and Isiolo **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; the **273** cases in **Nairobi**, are from Lang'ata (33), Kibra (26), Westlands (22), Makadara (20), Dagoretti North and Kasarani (19) cases each, Starehe (18), Embakasi West and Kamukunji (17) cases each, Roysambu (15), Mathare and Ruaraka (12), Embakasi Central (11), Embakasi East and Embakasi South (9) cases each, Embakasi North (8), Dagoretti South (6). In **Mombasa**, the **78** cases are from Mvita (27), Jomvu (20), Changamwe (19), Nyali (6), Kisauni (4) and Likoni (2). In **Nakuru**, the **73** cases are from Nakuru West (60), Naivasha, Nakuru East and Rongai (4) cases each, Gilgil (1). In **Kiambu**, the **55** cases are from Ruiru (15), Kiambu Town and Thika (8) cases each, Kabete and Kikuyu (6) cases each, Gatundu South (5), Juja (4), Lari (2) and Kiambaa (1). In **Kirinyaga**, the **49** cases are from Kirinyaga Central (47) and Mwea West (2). In **Nyamira**, all the **35** cases are from Nyamira Town. In **Kisumu**, the **27** cases are from Kisumu Central (19), Kisumu East (4), Kisumu West (2), Nyando and Seme (1) case each. In **Kilifi** the **23** cases are from Kilifi North (12), Malindi (8) and Kaloleni (3). In **Kajiado**, the **23** cases are from Kajiado North (14), Kajiado Central (6), Kajiado East (3). In **Uasin Gishu**, the **21** cases are from Ainabkoi (19) and Turbo (2). In **Nyeri** the **21** cases are from Nyeri Central (12), Kieni West and Mukurweini (3) cases each, Mathira West (2) and Tetu (1). In **Meru**, the **19** cases are from Imenti North (10), Buuri (4), Imenti South (3), Imenti Central and Tigania East (1) case each. In **Kericho**, the **18** cases are from Ainamoi (14), Belgut and Kipkelion East (2)

cases each. In **Busia**, the **16** cases are from Matayos (11) and Teso North (5). In **Machakos**, the **15** cases are from Athi River (8), Machakos Town (4), Mwala (2) and Kangundo (1). In **Kisii**, the **13** cases are from Kitutu Chache South (10), Nyaribari Chache (2) and South Mugirango (1). In **Bomet**, the 12 cases are from Bomet East (7) and Bomet Central (5). In **Tana River**, all the **11** cases are from Galole. In **Siaya**, the 11 cases are from Rarieda (4), Alego Usonga (3), Ugenya (2), Bondo and Ugunja (1) case each. In **Migori** the 10 cases are from Suna West (5), Rongo (3), Awendo and Uriri (1) case each. In **Taita Taveta**, the **9** cases are from Wundanyi (4), Mwatate (3) and Voi (2). In **Laikipia**, the 9 cases are from Laikipia East (5) and Laikipia West (4). In **Bungoma**, the **8** cases are from Kanduyi and Kimilili (4) cases each, while in **Baringo** the **8** cases are from Baringo North (7) and Baringo Central (1). In **Murang'a**, the **4** cases are from Kiharu and Maragua (2) cases each, while the **4** cases in **Embu** are from Manyatta (3) and Runyenjes (1). The **3** cases in **Homa Bay** are from Homa Bay Town (2) and Kabondo Kasipui (1). All the **3** cases in **Vihiga** are from Vihiga, the **3** cases in **Kitui** are from Mwingi Central (2) and Kitui West (1), while the **3** cases in **Lamu** are from Lamu West. In **Garissa** the **2** cases are from Dadaab and Garissa Town with (1) case each. In **Nandi** the **2** cases are from Emgwen and Tinderet with (1) case each. The **case** in **Nyandarua**, is from Kinangop, the **case** in **Narok** is from Narok East, the **case** in **Wajir** is from Wajir East, the **case** in **Makueni** is from Kibwezi East and the **case** in **Isiolo** is from Isiolo Town.

Today, **322** patients have recovered from the disease, **259** from the Home-Based Care Program, while **63** have been discharged from various hospitals. Total recoveries now stand at to **68,110**.

Unfortunately, **6** patients have succumbed to the disease bringing the cumulative fatalities to **1,506**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

Currently there are **1,194** patients admitted in various health facilities countrywide with **7,984** on Home Based Isolation and Care. **77** patients are in Intensive Care Units (ICU), **31** of whom are on ventilatory support, and **45** on supplemental oxygen.

Another **67** patients are separately on supplementary oxygen out of whom **57** are in; general wards. **10** are in High Dependency Units (HDU).
