**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**  
**MEASURES, AS AT February 9, 2021**

**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **104** people have tested positive to the disease, out of a sample size of **3,348** tested in the last 24 hours. The total confirmed positive cases are now **102,048**. The cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,220,043**. From the cases **77** are Kenyans while **27** are foreigners. **66** are males while **38** are females. The youngest is a **two-month-old infant** while the oldest is **101**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **68**, Laikipia **7**, Kiambu **6**, Uasin Gishu **6**, Siaya **3**, Nakuru **3**, Kisumu **2**, Nandi **2**, Machakos

**2**, Kajiado **1**, Kakamega **1**, Kericho **1**, Murang'a **1** and Taita Taveta **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; the **68** cases in **Nairobi** are from Lang'ata (16), Dagoretti North (9), Westlands (6), Kibra (5), Embakasi Central, Kamukunji and Makadara (4) cases each, Embakasi North, Embakasi South and Embakasi West (3) cases each, Kasarani, Mathare, Roysambu and Ruaraka (2) cases each, Dagoretti South, Embakasi East and Starehe (1) case each.

In **Laikipia** all the **7** cases are from Laikipia East. In **Kiambu** the **6** cases are from Kiambu Town and Ruiru (2) cases each, Kabete and Kikuyu (1) case each. In **Uasin Gishu** all the **6** cases are from Ainabkoi. In **Siaya** the **3** cases are from Alego Usonga (2) and Rarieda (1) while in **Nakuru** the **3** cases are from Nakuru East (2) and Naivasha (1).

The **2** cases in **Kisumu** are all from Kisumu Central, the **2** cases in **Nandi** are from Chesumei and Emgwen (1) case each, while the **2** cases in **Machakos** are from Kangundo and Machakos Town (1) case each. The **case** in **Kajiado** is from Kajiado East, the **case** in **Kakamega** is from Lurambi, the **case** in **Kericho** is from Ainamoi, the **case** in **Murang'a** is from Kigumo and the **case** in **Taita Taveta** is from Voi.

Today, **69** patients have recovered from the disease. **37** from various health facilities while **32** are from the Home-Based Isolation and Care. Total recoveries now stand at **84,542**.

Unfortunately, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease pushing the cumulative fatality to **1,789**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

There are **368** patients currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,315** are on Home Based Isolation and Care. **37** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **13** of whom are on ventilatory support and **21** on supplemental oxygen. **3** patients are under observation.

Another **11** patients are separately on supplementary oxygen and all of them are in the general wards.
