**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **152** people have tested positive to the disease, out of a sample size of **3,734** tested in the last 24 hours. The total confirmed positive cases are now **103,993**. The cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,262,358**. From the cases **137** are Kenyans while **15** are foreigners. **104** are males and **48** are females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **88**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **105**, Nakuru **8**, Mombasa **8**, Kiambu **7**, Uasin Gishu **7**, Machakos **3**, Taita Taveta **3**, Kajiado

2, Nyeri **2**, Kisumu **2**, Makueni **1**, Meru **1**, Murang'a **1**, Nandi **1** and Kakamega **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; the **105** cases in **Nairobi** are from Lang'ata (36), Embakasi Central (14), Dagoretti North (13), Kamukunji (6), Westlands (5), Kasarani and Roysambu (4) cases each, Kibra, Mathare, Ruaraka and Starehe (3) cases each, Dagoretti South, Embakasi East, Embakasi South, Embakasi West and Makadara (2) cases each, Embakasi North (1).

In **Nakuru** the **8** cases are from Nakuru East (6) and Naivasha (2). In **Mombasa** the **8** cases are from Nyali (6) and Mvita (2). In **Kiambu** the **7** cases are from Ruiru (2), Juja, Kiambaa, Kiambu Town, Lari and Limuru (1) case each.

In **Uasin Gishu** the **7** cases are from Ainabkoi (5), Kesses and Turbo (1) case each. In **Machakos** all the **3** cases are from Athi River. In **Taita Taveta** all the **3** cases are from Voi.

The **2** cases in **Kajiado** are all from Kajiado North, the **2** cases in **Nyeri** are from Mathira East and Tetu (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Kisumu** are from Kisumu Central and Kisumu West with (1) case each, and the **2** cases in **Makueni** are all from Mbooni.

The **case** in **Meru** is from Imenti Central, the **case** in **Murang'a** is from Maragua, the **case** in **Nandi** is from Emgwen and the **case** in **Kakamega** is from Lurambi.



Today, **8** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from our various health facilities. Total recoveries now stand at **85,540**.

Sadly, **4** patients have succumbed to the disease pushing our cumulative fatality to **1,817**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

There are **335** patients currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,151** patients are on Home Based Isolation and Care.

47 patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **18** of whom are on ventilatory support and **24** on supplemental oxygen. **5** patients are on observation. Another **9** patients are separately on supplementary oxygen with **8** of them in general wards and **1** in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
