**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **139** people have tested positive to the disease, out of a sample size of **5,487** tested in the last 24 hours. The total confirmed positive cases are now **99,769**. The cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,148,030**. From the cases **119** are Kenyans while **20** are foreigners. **90** are males while **49** are females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **85**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **81**, Mombasa **13**, Turkana **11**, Kwale **3**, Laikipia **3**, Isiolo **2**, Nakuru **2**, Bomet **2**, Trans Nzoia **2**, Nyeri **2**, Migori **2**, Nandi **1**, Nyamira **1**, Nyandarua

1, Murang'a **1**, Taita Taveta **1**, Busia **1**, Embu **1**, Kiambu **1**, Kisumu **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kericho **1**, Siaya **1**, Kitui **1**, Machakos **1**, Kilifi **1**, and West Pokot **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; the **81** cases in **Nairobi** are from Kibra (10), Embakasi West and Lang'ata (9) cases each, Starehe (8), Dagoretti North and Ruaraka (6) cases each, Makadara (5), Dagoretti South, Embakasi South, Kamukunji and Mathare (4) cases each, Embakasi Central and Westlands (3) cases each, Kasarani and Roysambu (2) cases each, Embakasi East and Embakasi North (1) case each.

In **Mombasa**, the **13** cases are from Mvita (6), Nyali (3), Changamwe, Jomvu, Kisauni and Likoni (1) case each. In **Turkana**, the **11** cases are from Turkana West (8) and Turkana Central (3). In **Kwale**, all the **3**, cases are from Msambweni. In **Laikipia**, the **3** cases are from Laikipia East (2) and Laikipia West (1).

The **2** cases in **Isiolo** are all from Isiolo Town, the **2** cases in **Nakuru**, are from Nakuru East and Rongai (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Bomet** are all from Bomet Central, the **2** cases in **Trans Nzoia** are all from Kiminini, the **2** cases in **Nyeri** are from

Mukurweini and Nyeri Central (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Migori** are all from Kuria West.

The **case** in **Nandi** is from Emgwen, the **case** in **Nyamira** is from Manga, the **case** in **Nyandarua** is from Kinangop, the **case** in **Murang'a** is from Kangema, the **case** in **Taita Taveta** is from Voi, the **case** in **Busia** is from Teso South and the **case** in **Embu** is from Manyatta.

The **case** in **Kiambu** is from Githunguri, the **case** in **Kisumu** is from Kisumu Central, the **case** in **Kajiado** is from Kajiado North, and the **case** in **Kericho** is from Kipkelion East.

The **case** in **Siaya** is from Alego Usonga, the **case** in **Kitui** is from Kitui East, the **case** in **Machakos** is from Athi River, the **case** in **Kilifi** is from Kilifi North and the **case** in **West Pokot** is from West Pokot.



Today, **137** patients have recovered from the disease. **110** are from our various facilities and **27** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care. Total recoveries now stand at **82,866**.

Sadly, **1** patient has succumbed to the disease pushing our fatality to **1,740**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of the departed.

Currently there are **577** patients admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,553** are on Home Based Isolation and Care. **27** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **16** of whom are on ventilatory support and **10** on supplemental oxygen. **1** patient is under observation.

Another **15** patients are separately on supplementary oxygen with **10** of them in the general wards. **5** patients are in the High Dependency Unit.
