PRESS STATEMENT

Today **186** people have tested positive to the disease, out of a sample size of **8,049** tested in the last 24 hours. The total confirmed positive cases are now **99,630**. The cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,142,543**. From the cases **158** are Kenyans while **28** are foreigners. **112** are males while **74** are females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **85**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **95**, Mombasa **23**, Busia **17**, Kiambu **10**, Isiolo **6**, Kwale **6**, Nakuru **5**, Uasin Gishu **5**, Taita Taveta **3**, Kajiado **2**, Siaya **2**, Kakamega **2**, Machakos **2**, Kisumu

2, Kilifi **1**, Nandi **1**, Nyamira **1**, Makueni **1**, Migori **1** and Bungoma **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; the **95** cases in **Nairobi** are from Lang'ata (19), Dagoretti North (15), Westlands (9), Kibra (8), Embakasi Central (7), Kasarani, Ruaraka and Starehe (5) cases each, Dagoretti South, Embakasi East and Embakasi South (4) cases each, Embakasi West (3), Embakasi North and Mathare (2) cases each, Kamukunji, Makadara, and Roysambu (1) case each.

In **Mombasa**, the **23** cases are from Mvita (17), Likoni (2), Changamwe, Jomvu, Kisauni and Nyali (1) case each. In **Busia**, the **17** cases are from Matayos (11), Teso South (5) and Teso North (1).

In **Kiambu**, the **10** cases are from Kiambu Town (4), Gatundu South, Githunguri, Kabete, Kiambaa, Ruiru and Thika (1) case each. In **Isiolo**, all the **6** cases are from Isiolo Town. In **Kwale**, the **6** cases are from Lungalunga (5) and Msambweni (1).

In **Nakuru**, the **5** cases are from Nakuru East (4) and Njoro (1). In **Uasin Gishu**, the **5** cases are from Ainabkoi (4) and Turbo (1). In **Taita Taveta**, the **3** cases are from Taveta (2) and Voi (1).

The **2** cases in **Kajiado**, are from Kajiado East and Loitokitok (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Siaya**, are from Alego Usonga and Rarieda (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Kakamega**, are from Lurambi and Mumias West (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Machakos**, are from Athi River and Machakos (1) case each and the **2** cases in Kisumu are from Kisumu Central.

The **case** in **Kilifi**, is from Kilifi North, the **case** in **Nandi**, is from Emgwen, the **case** in **Nyamira**, is from Manga, the **case** in **Makueni**, is from Makueni, the **case** in **Migori**, is from Suna East and the **case** in **Bungoma**, is from Webuye East.

Today **75** patients have recovered from the disease. **34** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care, while **41** are from our various facilities. The total recoveries now stand at **82,729**.

Unfortunately, **3** patients have lost their lives to the disease pushing our cumulative fatalities to **1,739**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

Currently there are **674** patients admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,543** are on Home Based Isolation and Care. **33** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **16** of

whom are on ventilatory support and **15** on supplemental oxygen.
2 are under observation.

Another **12** patients are separately on supplementary oxygen with
11 of them in the general wards. **1** patient is in the High
Dependency Unit.
