**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **2,008** people have tested positive to the disease, from a sample size of **11,360** tested in the last 24 hours. Our positivity rate is at **17.7%**. From the cases **1,954** are Kenyans while **54** are foreigners. **1,090** are males and **918** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old baby** while the oldest is **94**. Total confirmed positive cases are now **128,178** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,455,061**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **1,071**, Nakuru **189**, Kiambu **105**, Machakos **84**, Mombasa **76**, Uasin Gishu **64**, Kitui **54**, Kisumu **41**, Meru **34**, Tharaka Nithi **31**, Kajiado **26**, Kakamega **25**, Murang'a **25**, Garissa **24**, Makueni **21**, Baringo **20**, Nyandarua **15**, Trans Nzoia
