**Background**

- Vaccines Received- 1,120,000 (Inclusive of 100,000 donations by Government of India)
- Vaccinations began on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Countrywide vaccinations started on the week of 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021
- Total Doses distributed to 9 Regional Depots **999,000**
- Balance at Kitengela Central Vaccines **121,000**
- Total vaccinated to date are **526,026** persons across the counties. 56.5% are male while 43.5% are female (1.3:1)

## Cumulative Vaccinations by Occupation on 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2021

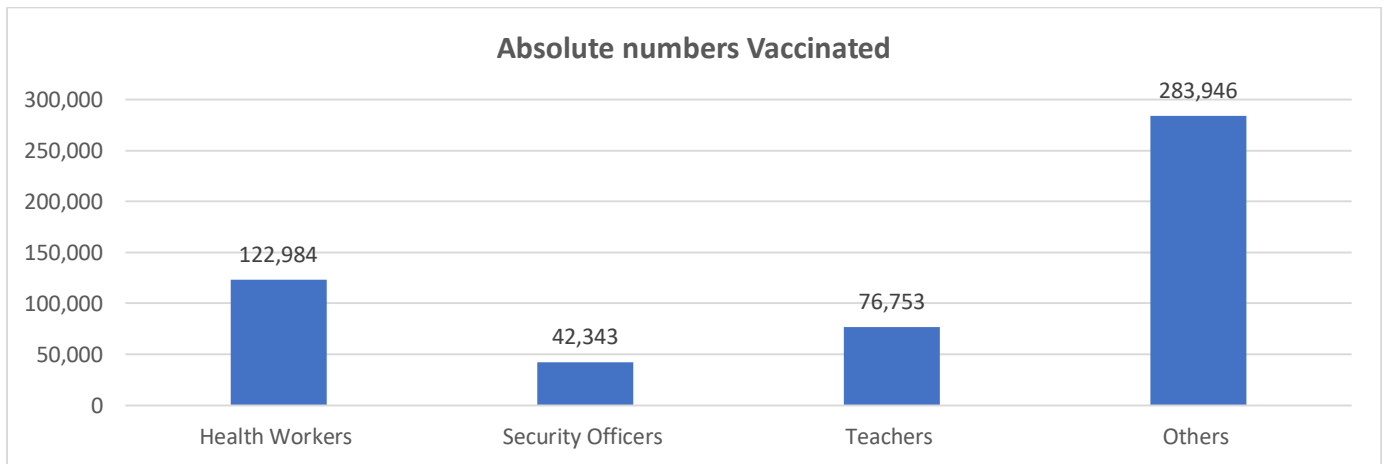


Figure 1: Bar graph of absolute numbers vaccinated

- Figure 1 shows that uptake by category. Others (58 yrs and above) is the highest at 54%, followed by health care workers at 23%, Teachers at 15% and Security at 8%
- Table3 shows that 59% of health care workers have been vaccinated, 23% teachers and 11% of those above 58 years

- ✓ Stock levels shows a total of 520,006 doses dispensed with 284, 017 in stocks at the Regional and Sub Counties
- ✓ The difference of 6,020 doses is linked to data that has not been uploaded into the Chanjo system
