Background

- Vaccines Received- 1,020,000 Covax
- 100,000 donations by Government of India
- Total vaccines 1,120,000
- Vaccinations began on 5th March 2021
- Countrywide vaccinations started on the week of 8th March 2021

By 8th April, 2021

- Total Doses distributed to 9 Regional Depots 999,000
- Balance of vaccines at Kitengela Central stores 121,000
- Total persons Vaccinated 421,021

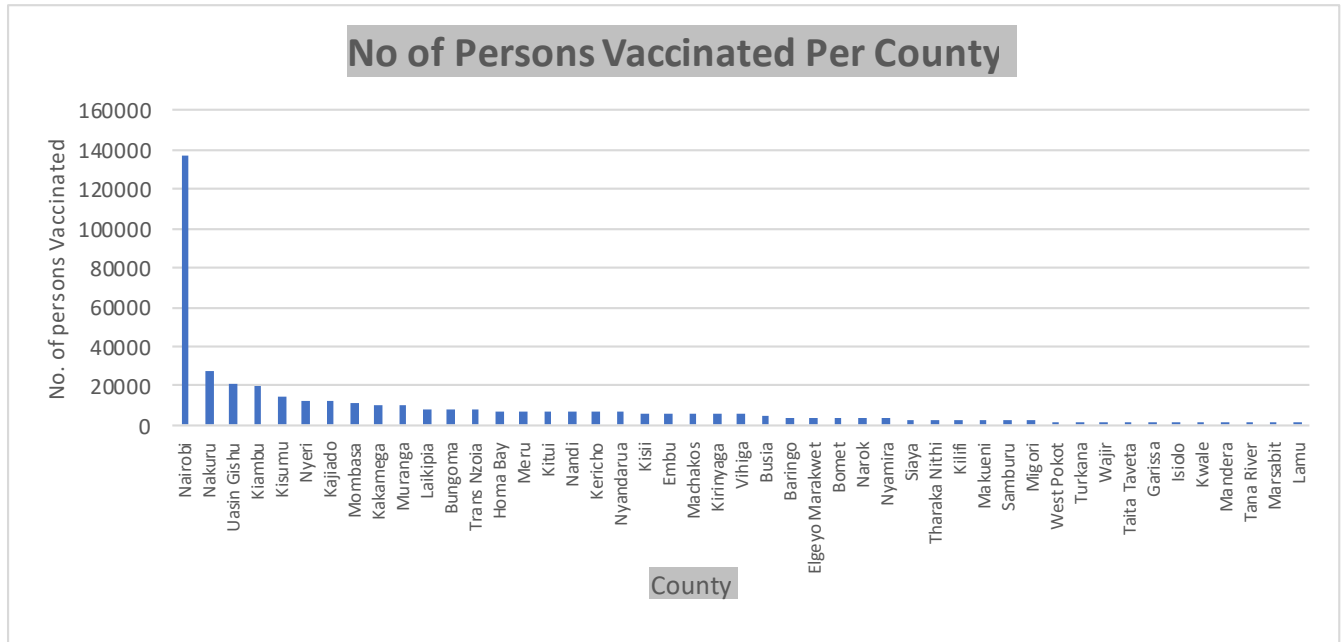

- Of vaccinated people 56.5% are male while 43.5% are female
- Nairobi County contributed 33% of the total vaccinated followed by Nakuru, Uasin Gishu and Kiambu counties at 6%, 5% and 5% respectively
- Lamu County with uptake of 339 persons vaccinated

- Table 2 shows the proportion of uptake by occupation, Overall, others (mainly those above 58 years of age) are leading in the uptake of vaccine at 52%, followed by health care workers at 26%

Progress towards meeting targets

Table 3 shows the progress made towards meeting the national targets for Covid 19 vaccination amongst priority groups. More than 53% of health care workers have been vaccinated, 18% teachers and 8% of those above 58 years.
