**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **633** people have tested positive to the disease, out of a sample size of **5,193** tested in the last 24 hours. The total confirmed positive cases are now **108,362**. The cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,327,999**. From the cases **554** are Kenyans while **79** are foreigners. **384** are males and **249** are females. The youngest is **a one-year-old baby** while the oldest is **85**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **430**, Kiambu **58**, Nakuru **44**, Kajiado **19**, Migori **17**, Uasin Gishu **14**, Mombasa **7**, Machakos **7**, Trans Nzoia **5**, Kisumu **4**, Kilifi **3**, Kakamega **3**, Makueni **3**, Bungoma **2**, Kitui **2**, Narok **2**, Nyandarua **2**, Nyeri **1**, Siaya **1**, Taita Taveta **1**, Turkana **1**, Homa Bay **1**, Laikipia **1**, Lamu **1**, Meru **1**, Murang'a **1**, Kericho **1** and Kisii **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; the **430** cases in **Nairobi** are from Dagoretti North (57), Westlands (51), Kibra (45), Lang'ata (44), Starehe (36), Kasarani (26), Kamukunji (25), Embakasi West and Makadara (19) cases each, Dagoretti South (18), Embakasi East (17), Roysambu (15), Embakasi South and Ruaraka (14) cases each, Embakasi Central and Embakasi North (12) cases each, Mathare (6).

In **Kiambu** the **58** cases are from Kiambu Town (19), Ruiru and Thika (7) cases each, Kiambaa (6), Juja, Kikuyu and Limuru (4) cases each, Kabete (3), Githunguri and Lari (2) cases each. In **Nakuru** the **44** cases are from Nakuru East (16), Nakuru West (10), Gilgil (8), Subukia (3), Naivasha, Nakuru North and Rongai (2) cases each, Njoro (1). In **Kajiado** the **19** cases are from Kajiado North (10), Kajiado East (6) and Kajiado Central (3).

In **Migori** the **17** cases are from Rongo (16) and Suna East (1). In **Uasin Gishu** the **14** cases are from Ainabkoi (10), Kapseret, Kesses, Moiben and Turbo (1) case each. In **Mombasa** the **7** cases are from Mvita (5) and Jomvu (2). In **Machakos** the **7** cases are from Athi River (4), Machakos (2) and Kangundo (1). In **Trans Nzoia** the **5** cases are from Kiminini (3) and Saboti (2).

In **Kisumu** the **4** cases are from Kisumu Central (3) and Kisumu East (1). In **Kilifi** the **3** cases are all from Kilifi North. In **Kakamega** the **3** cases are from Lurambi (2) and Lugari (1). In **Makueni** the **3** cases are from Kilome (2) and Makueni (1).

The **2** cases in **Bungoma** are all from Kanduyi, the **2** cases in **Kitui** are from Kitui West and Mwingi Central (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Narok** are from Narok North and Narok South (1) case each, and the **2** cases in **Nyandarua** are all from Kinangop.

The **case** in **Nyeri** is from Nyeri Central, the **case** in **Siaya** is from Alego Usonga, the **case** in **Taita Taveta** is from Voi, the **case** in **Turkana** is from Turkana West, the **case** in **Homa Bay** is from Homa Bay Town, the **case** in **Laikipia** is from Laikipia East, the **case** in **Lamu** is from Lamu West, the **case** in **Meru** is from Buuri, the **case** in **Murang'a** is from Kiharu, the **case** in

Kericho is from Ainamoi and the **case** in **Kisii** is from Kitutu Chache South.


Today, **374** patients have recovered from the disease, **328** from the Home Based and Isolation Care while **46** are from various health facilities. Total recoveries now stand at **87,550**.

Sadly, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease pushing our cumulative fatalities to **1,874**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of the deceased.

A total of **483** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,389** patients are on Home Based Isolation and Care. **69** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **26** of whom are on ventilatory support and **33** on supplemental oxygen. **10** patients are on observation.

Another **18** patients are separately on supplementary oxygen all of whom are in the general wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
