#### Background

- Vaccines Received **1,733,100**
- 1<sup>st</sup> Vaccinations began on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose Vaccination began on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose uptake. Male at 55% of those given dose 1 receiving 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, female at 45%, Health care workers 112,773 receiving dose 2, out of 174,303 that have received dose 1 giving a proportion of 64.7%, followed by 62.8% Above 58 years, Teachers 58% and security officers at 56.5% receiving dose 2.

Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 7.2% of the population fully vaccinated followed by Uasin Gishu with 4.2% while Garissa, Marsabit. Tana River is the least with 0.3% of the population fully vaccinated.
