Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 7.3% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 5.5%, Uasin Gishu with 4.2% Laikipia 3.8 % while Garissa, Marsabit, Tana River is the least with 0.3% of the population fully vaccinated.
