Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 7.9% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 6.0%, Uasin Gishu with 4.5% Laikipia 4.0%, Nakuru 3.7%, while Marsabit, is the least with 0.3% of the population fully vaccinated.
