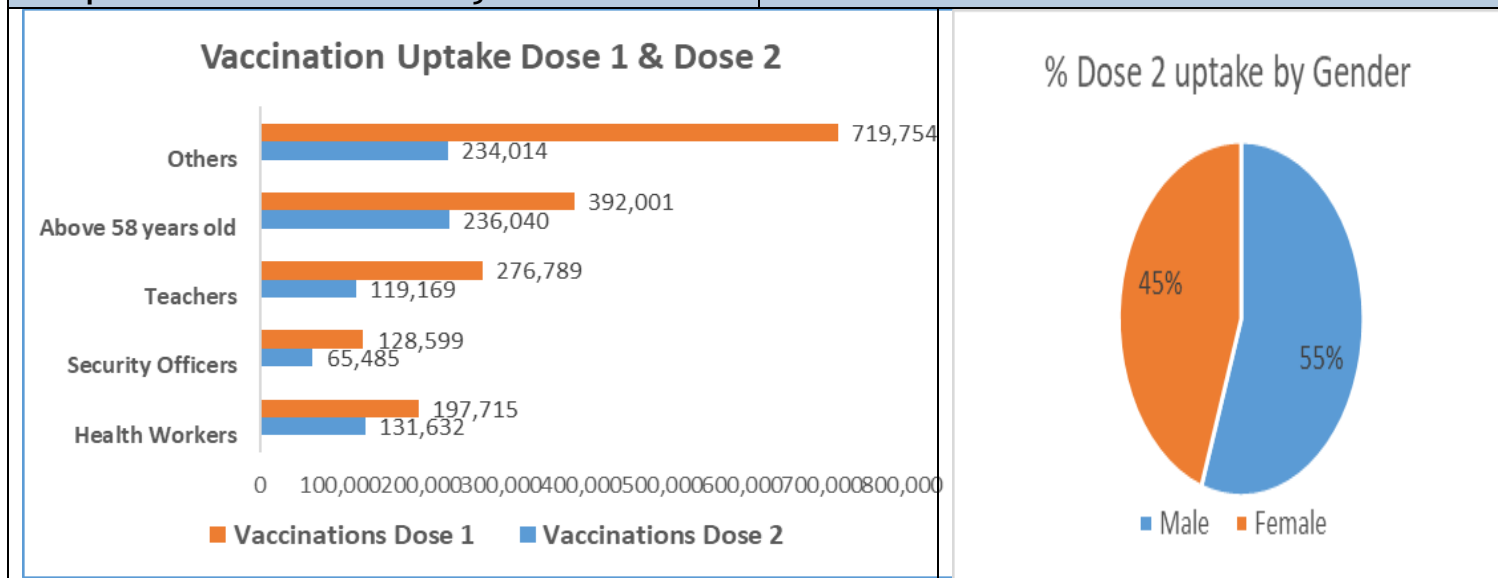


Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose uptake.

Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 8.5% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 6.3%, Uasin Gishu with 4.8% Laikipia 4.3%, Nakuru 3.9%, while Marsabit, is the least with 0.3%, of the population fully vaccinated.
