- 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose Vaccination began on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021

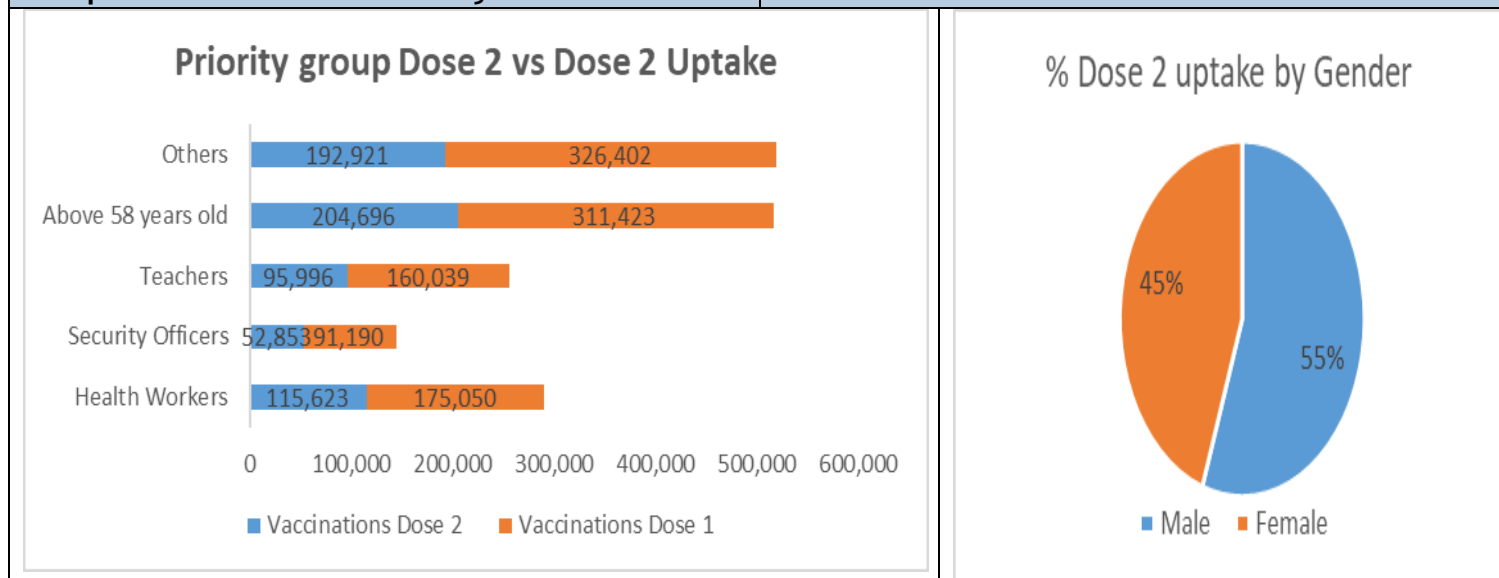


Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose uptake.

Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 7.4% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 5.6%, Uasin Gishu with 4.3% Laikipia 3.8 % while Garissa, Marsabit, Tana River is the least with 0.3% of the population fully vaccinated.
