Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 7.7% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 5.8%, Uasin Gishu with 4.4% Laikipia 3.9 %, Nakuru 3.5%, while Marsabit, is the least with 0.3% of the population fully vaccinated.
