Nairobi County in the lead with 7.4% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 5.6%, Uasin Gishu with 4.3% Laikipia 3.8 % while Garissa, Marsabit, Tana River is the least with 0.3% of the population fully vaccinated.
