### **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 11, 2021**

#### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **241** people have tested positive for the disease from a sample size of **2,961** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **8.1%**. From the cases, **222** are Kenyans while **19** are foreigners with **144** being males and **97** females. The youngest is a **six-month-old infant** while the oldest is aged **93**. Total confirmed positive cases now stand at **188,754** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,015,659**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi recorded **165 cases**, Kiambu **16**, Nyeri **11**, Nakuru **10**, Murang'a **6**, Mombasa **5**, Kajiado

**4**, Siaya **4**, Homa Bay **3**, Kisii **3**, Kwale **3**, Machakos **3**, Kilifi **2**, Meru **2** while Narok, Taita Taveta, Uasin Gishu and Bomet registered **1** case each.

In terms of Sub County distribution; the **165** cases in Nairobi are from Starehe (19), Kibra (16), Langata (15), Westlands (14), Roysambu and Ruaraka (12) cases each, Kasarani (11), Dagoretti North and South (9) cases each, Makadara (8), Embakasi West and Mathare (7) cases each, Embakasi central, North, South and Kamukunji (6) cases each, Embakasi East (2). In **Kiambu**, the **16** cases are from Ruiru (6), Kabete and Kikuyu (3) cases each, Kiambaa (2), Githunguri and Thika (1) case each.

In **Nyeri**, the **11** cases are from Mukurweini (8), Mathira East, Nyeri Central and Tetu (1) case each. In **Nakuru**, the **10** cases are from Naivasha (4), Nakuru East (3), Rongai (2), Gilgil (1). In **Murang'a**, the **6** cases are from Kandara (3), Gatanga, Kangema and Kiharu (1) case each. In **Mombasa**, the **5** cases are from Likoni and Mvita (2) cases each, Kisauni (1).

In **Kajiado**, the **4** cases are from Kajiado North (3) and East (1).

In **Siaya**, the **4** cases are from Gem and Ugunja (2) cases each.

The **3** cases in **Homa Bay**, are from Homa Bay Town, Mbita and Rachuonyo South (1) case each, the **3** cases in **Kisii** are from

Kitutu Chache South (2), Bomachoge Chache (1), the **3** cases in **Kwale** are from Msambweni and the **3** cases in **Machakos** are from Athi River. In **Kilifi**, the **2** cases are from Kaloleni and Rabai with (1) case each, while the **2** cases in **Meru** are from Buuri and Tigania East (1) case each. The **case** in **Narok** is from Narok North, the **case** in **Taita Taveta** is from Voi, the **case** in **Uasin Gishu** is from Ainabkoi and the **case** in **Bomet** is from Sotik.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**7**), 10-19 years (**16**), 20-29 years (**38**), 30-39 (**72**) 40-49 (**38**) 50-59 (**39**) 60 years and above (**31**).

Today, **1,401** patients have recovered from the disease with **1,380** from Home-Based Isolation and Care, while **21** are from various health facilities across the country. Total recoveries now stand at **179,520** out of which **143,338** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **36,182** are from various health facilities.

Sadly, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease, a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in July 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **3,722**. Our sincere

condolences to the family and friends of those that have lost their loved one.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(1)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 **(120)**, 30-39 years **(307)**, 40-49 years **(443)**, 50-59 years **(751)**, 60 years and above **(2,019)**.

A total of **1,092** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,077** are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **115** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **37** of whom are on ventilatory support and **58** on supplemental oxygen. **20** patients are under observation.

Another **209** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **185** in general wards and **24** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

**VACCINATION:** As of today, a total of **1,539,087** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first

doses are **1,026,960** while second doses are **512,127**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **49.9%** with the majority being males at **55%** while females are at **45%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **2.0%** The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Health Workers **98,044**, Aged 58 years and above **158,270**, Others **144,669**, Teachers **70,648** while Security Officers are at **40,496**.
