### **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 11, 2021**

#### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **488** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,831** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **8.4%**. From the cases **481** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **315** are males and **173** females. The youngest is a **three-month-old infant** while the oldest is **94** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **174,773** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,858,443**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **90**, Busia **72**, Siaya **71**, Kisumu **35**, Kericho **33**, Uasin Gishu **27**, Mombasa **23**, Bungoma

**21**, Nakuru **14**, Nandi **13**, Homa Bay **11**, Bomet **11**, Kisii **9**, Kirinyaga **8**, Kakamega **7**, Vihiga **6**, Kiambu **5**, Murang'a **4**, Kilifi **4**, Garissa **3**, Kajiado **3**, West Pokot **3**, Kitui **2**, Meru **2**, Migori **2**, Narok **1**, Nyamira **1**, Samburu **1**, Tharaka Nithi **1**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Embu **1**, Kwale **1** and Machakos **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **90** cases are from Roysambu (18), Westlands (9), Embakasi West (8), Dagoretti North, Kamukunji, Langata and Mathare (6) cases each, Embakasi East, Makadara and Starehe (5) cases each, Kasarani (4), Embakasi Central, Embakasi North and Ruaraka (3) cases each, Dagoretti South (2), Embakasi South (1). In **Busia** the **72** cases are from Matayos (53), Teso North (16), Teso South (3). In **Siaya** the **71** cases are from Alego-Usonga (50), Rarieda (11), Bondo (5), Gem and Ugunja (2) cases each, Ugenya (1).

In **Kisumu** the **35** cases are from Kisumu Central (19), Kisumu West (7), Kisumu East (6), Muhoroni, Nyakach and Nyando (1) case each. In **Kericho** the **33** cases are from Ainamoi (29), Bureti (3), Belgut (1). In **Uasin Gishu** the **27** cases are from Ainabkoi (12), Turbo (9), Kapseret (3), Kesses (2), Soy (1). In **Mombasa** the **23** cases are from Jomvu (9), Kisauni (6), Nyali (5), Changamwe (2), Likoni (1). In **Bungoma** the **21** cases are from

Webuye West (7), Kanduyi (5), Kimilili (4), Mt Elgon (3), Tongaren (2). In **Nakuru** the **14** cases are from Nakuru East (4), Naivasha, Nakuru North and Nakuru West (2) cases each, Kuresoi North, Molo, Njoro and Subukia (1) case each.

In **Nandi** all the **13** cases are from Emgwen. In **Homa Bay** the **11** cases are from Homa Bay Town (5), Rachuonyo South (4), Karachuonyo and Ndhiwa (1) case each. In **Bomet** the **11** cases are from Bomet Central (5), Bomet East (3), Chepalungu (2), Sotik (1). In **Kisii** the **9** cases are from Kitutu Chache South (8), Bobasi (1). In **Kirinyaga** the **8** cases are from Kirinyaga Central (7), Kirinyaga East (1). In **Kakamega** the **7** cases are from Lurambi (5), Khwisero (2).

In **Vihiga** the **6** cases are from Hamisi and Vihiga (2) cases each, Emuhaya and Luanda (1) case each. In **Kiambu** the **5** cases are from Ruiru (2), Githunguri, Kiambu Town and Kikuyu (1) case each. In **Murang'a** the **4** cases are from Kiharu (3), Kandara (1). In **Kilifi** the **4** cases are from Magarini (3), Malindi (1). In **Garissa** the **3** cases are from Dadaab (2), Garissa Town (1). In **Kajiado** all the **3** cases are from Kajiado North. In **West Pokot** the **3** cases are from West Pokot (2), Pokot South (1).

The **2** cases in **Kitui** are from Kitui South and Mwingi North (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Meru** are from Imenti North and the **2**

cases in **Migori** are from Suna East and Uriri (1) case each. The **case** in **Narok** is from Trans Mara, the **case** in **Nyamira** is from Manga, the **case** in **Samburu** is from Samburu Central, the **case** in **Tharaka Nithi** is from Tharaka South, the **case** in **Trans Nzoia** is from Endebess, the **case** in **Elgeyo Marakwet** is from Keiyo North, the **case** in **Embu** is from Manyatta, the **case** in **Kwale** is from Msambweni and the **case** in **Machakos** is from Machakos Town.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(13)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 years **(100)**, 30-39 **(100)** 40-49 **(91)** 50-59 **(60)** 60 years and above **(86)**.

Today **343** patients have recovered from the disease, **274** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **69** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **119,589** of whom **86,870** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **32,719** are from various health facilities.

Sadly, **16** people have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting Facility Record Audits on diverse dates in the months of April, May and June. This now

pushes the cumulative fatalities to **3,378**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(3)**, 50-59 years **(1)**, 60 years and above **(11)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(55)**, 10-19 years **(23)**, 20-29 **(110)**, 30-39 years **(276)**, 40-49 years **(416)**, 50-59 years **(698)**, 60 years and above **(1,800)**.

A total of **969** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,827** patients are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **162** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **30** of whom are on ventilatory support and **113** on supplemental oxygen. **19** patients are under observation.

Another **106** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **101** of them in General Wards and **5** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

## **VACCINATION:**

As of today, a total of **1,095,122** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **985,070** while total 2nd doses are **110,052**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **11.17%** with the majority being males at **56.4%** while females are at **43.6%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **less than 1%**.

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows; Health Workers **33,425**, Aged 58 years and above **29,635**, Others **28,196**, Teachers **11,328** while Security Officers **7,468**.
