UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 12, 2021

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **188** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,354** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **8.0%**. From the cases **174** are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **102** are males and **86** females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **85** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **188,942** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,018,013**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **128**, Kiambu **10**, Machakos **9**, Siaya **7**, Kwale **7**, Nakuru **7**, Embu **3**, Kajiado **3**,

Murang'a **3**, Makueni **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Garissa **1**, Kilifi **1**, Homa Bay **1**, Laikipia **1**, Kakamega **1**, Nyeri **1** and Mandera **1**.

In terms of Sub County distribution; the **128** cases in **Nairobi** are from Makadara (14), Ruaraka (12), Starehe (11), Kasarani (10), Embakasi East and South (9) cases each, Embakasi Central and Kibra (8) cases each, Roysambu and Westlands (7) cases each, Langata (6), Dagoretti South, Kamukunji and Mathare (5) cases each, Dagoretti North, Embakasi North and West (4) cases each. In **Kiambu** the **10** cases are from Ruiru (5), Kiambu Town (2), Juja, Kabete and Kikuyu (1) case each.

In **Machakos** the **9** cases are from Machakos Town (3), Athi River, Kalama, Kangundo, Matungulu, Mwala and Yatta (1) case each. In **Siaya** the **7** cases are from Alego Usonga (5), Gem and Ugenya (1) case each. In **Kwale** the **7** cases are from Kinango (6), Matuga (1). In **Nakuru** the **7** cases are from Naivasha and Rongai (2) cases each, Nakuru East, West, and Njoro (1) case each.

In **Embu** the **3** cases are from Manyatta. In **Kajiado** the **3** cases are from Kajiado North. In **Murang'a** the **3** cases are from Gatanga, Maragua and Mathioya (1) case each. In **Makueni** the **2** cases are from Kaiti and Kibwezi East (1) case each while in **Uasin Gishu** the **2** cases are from Ainabkoi.

The **case** in **Garissa** is from Garissa Town, the **case** in **Kilifi** is from Rabai, the **case** in **Homa Bay** is from Baringo Central, the **case** in **Laikipia** is from Laikipia East, the **case** in **Kakamega** is from Matungu, the **case** in **Nyeri** is from Mathira West and the **case** in **Mandera** is from Mandera Central.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**4**), 10-19 years (**9**), 20-29 years (**38**), 30-39 (**53**) 40-49 (**43**) 50-59 (**27**) 60 years and above (**14**).

Today **341** patients have recovered from the disease with **250** from Home-Based Isolation and Care, while **91** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **179,861** out of which **143,588** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **36,273** are from various health facilities.

Unfortunately, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease and it is a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in July 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **3,723**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those that have lost their loved one.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 **(120)**, 30-39 years **(307)**, 40-49 years **(443)**, 50-59 years **(751)**, 60 years and above **(2,020)**.

A total of **1,062** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,381** are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **120** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **41** of whom are on ventilatory support and **59** on supplemental oxygen. **20** patients are under observation.

Another **223** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **201** of them in general wards and **22** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of today, a total of **1,547,092** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,028,121** while second doses are **518,971**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first

dose is at **50.5%** with the majority being males at **55%** while females are at **45%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **2.0%**
The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows:
Aged 58 years and above **160,418**, Others **146,936**, Health Workers **98,901**, Teachers **71,746** while Security Officers are at **40,970**.
