**UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE
MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 18, 2021**

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **796** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **7,392** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **10.8%**. From the cases **746** are Kenyans while **50** are foreigners. **458** are males and **338** females. The youngest is a **two-day-old infant** while the oldest is **96** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **178,078** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,895,028**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **174**, Siaya **138**, Kisumu **92**, Bomet **62**, Mombasa **46**, Busia **41**, Homa Bay **30**, Kisii **24**, Uasin Gishu **24**, Vihiga **23**, Kakamega **19**, Nakuru **16**, Trans Nzoia **15**, Bungoma **13**, Kilifi **11**, Kiambu **9**, Kajiado **8**, Kericho **8**, Meru **8**, Nandi **6**, Garissa **4**, Kwale **4**, Migori **3**, Lamu **2**, Murang'a **2**, Nyandarua **2**, Nyeri **2**, Taita Taveta **2**, Turkana **2**, West Pokot **2**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Laikipia **1**, Machakos **1** and Narok **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **174** cases are from Starehe (27), Langata (22), Westlands (18), Dagoretti North (15), Kibra (14), Kamukunji (12), Kasarani (11), Makadara (10), Dagoretti South (7), Mathare and Roysambu (6) cases each, Embakasi East, Embakasi South and Ruaraka (5) cases each, Embakasi Central and Embakasi North (4) cases each, Embakasi West (3). In **Siaya** the **138** cases are from Alego Usonga (79), Bondo (22), Ugunja (15), Rarieda (14), Gem and Ugenya (4) cases each.

In **Kisumu** the **92** cases are from Kisumu Central (70), Kisumu West (11), Seme (6), Kisumu East (3), Nyakach and Nyando (1) case each. In **Bomet** the **62** cases are from Bomet Central and Sotik (25) cases each, Bomet East, Chepalungu and Konoin (4) cases each. In **Mombasa** the **46** cases are from Mvita (22), Jomvu

(8), Kisauni (6), Likoni (5), Nyali (3), Changamwe (2). In **Busia** the **41** cases are from Matayos (27), Teso North (10), Butula (3), Teso South (1).

In **Homa Bay** the **30** cases are from Homa Bay Town (13), Karachuonyo (8), Mbita (4), Ndhiwa and Rachuonyo South (2) cases each, Suba North (1). In **Kisii** the **24** cases are from Bomachoge Chache, Kitutu Chache South and South Mugirango (7) cases each, Nyaribari Chache (3). In **Uasin Gishu** the **24** cases are from Kapseret (7), Kesses (6) Ainabkoi (4) and Moiben (4) cases each, Soy (2), Turbo (1). In **Vihiga** the **23** cases are from Vihiga (13), Emuhaya (4), Hamisi and Sabatia (3) cases each.

In **Kakamega** the **19** cases are from Lurambi (9), Kwhisero, Lugari and Matungu (2) cases each, Ikolomani, Mumias East, Navakholo and Shinyalu (1) case each. In **Nakuru** the **16** cases are from Naivasha (6), Nakuru East and Nakuru West (3) cases each, Kuresoi North, Njoro, Rongai and Subukia (1) case each. In **Trans Nzoia** the **15** cases are from Kiminini (8), Kwanza (4), Cherangany, Endebess and Saboti (1) case each. In **Bungoma** the **13** cases are from Kanduyi (4), Kimilili and Webuye West (3) cases each, Bumula (2), Sirisia (1). In **Kilifi** all the **11** cases are from Malindi.

In **Kiambu** the **9** cases are from Kabete, Lari and Thika (2) cases each, Kiambaa, Kiambaa Town and Ruiru (1) case each. In **Kajiado** the **8** cases are from Kajiado East (5) and Kajiado North (3). In **Kericho** the **8** cases are from Belgut and Bureti (3) cases each, Ainamoi and Sigowet/Soin (1) case each.

In **Meru** the **8** cases are from Imenti North (3), Imenti Central (2), Buuri, Igembe Central and Imenti South (1) case each. In **Nandi** the **6** cases are from Emgwen and Tinderet (2) cases each, Chesumei and Mosop (1) case each. In **Garissa** the **4** cases are from Dadaab while in **Kwale** the **4** cases are from Msambweni (3), Kinango (1). In **Migori** the **3** cases are from Suna East (2), Uriri (1).

The **2** cases in **Lamu** are from Lamu West, the **2** cases in **Murang'a** are from Kiharu, the **2** cases in **Nyandarua** are from Oljoroorok, the **2** cases in **Nyeri** are from Nyeri South and Tetu (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Taita Taveta** are from Voi, the **2** cases in **Turkana** are from Turkana West and the **2** cases in **West Pokot** are from West Pokot. The **case** in **Elgeyo Marakwet** is from Keiyo North, the **case** in **Laikipia** is from Laikipia East, the **case** in **Machakos** is from Mwala and the **case** in **Narok** is from Narok East.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(28)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 years **(129)**, 30-39 **(195)** 40-49 **(144)** 50-59 **(125)** 60 years and above **(149)**.

Today **328** patients have recovered from the disease, **307** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program, while **21** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **122,346** of whom **88,786** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **33,560** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **three** patients have succumbed to the disease in the last 24 hours, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting Facility Record Audits on diverse dates in the months of April and May. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **3,437**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**55**), 10-19 years (**23**), 20-29 (**111**), 30-39 years (**284**), 40-49 years (**420**), 50-59 years (**704**), 60 years and above (**1,840**).

A total of **1,097** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,842** patients are under the Home Based Isolation and Care program. **89** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **26** of whom are on ventilatory support and **49** on supplemental oxygen. **14** patients are under observation.

Another **114** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **109** of them in general wards and **5** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of today, a total of **1,174,071** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **993,670** while second doses are **180,401**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **18.2%** with the majority being males at **56%** while males are at **44%** Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is now at **0.7%**

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows:
Health Workers **49,960**, Aged 58 years and above **49,406**, Others
47,390, Teachers **20,618** while Security Officers are at **13,027**.
