UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 22, 2021

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **801** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,850** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **13.7%**. From the cases **784** are Kenyans while **17** are foreigners. **426** are males and **375** females. The youngest is a **one-year-old baby** while the oldest is **98** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **195,111** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,074,610**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **319**, Mombasa **77**, Kilifi **71**, Nakuru **60**, Uasin Gishu **45**, Kiambu **36**, Makueni **28**, Machakos **17**, Siaya **12**, Kajiado **11**, Nyandarua **11**, Kericho **11**, Homa Bay **10**, Nyeri **9**, Taita Taveta **9**, Murang'a **9**, Kisumu **9**, Kirinyaga **8**, Embu **5**, Laikipia **5**, Lamu **5**, Garissa **5**, Bungoma **4**, Kwale **4**, Turkana **4**, Migori **3**, Nandi **3**, Nyamira **3**, Kisii **2**, Kitui **2**, Narok **1**, Baringo **1**, Bomet **1** and Marsabit **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**31**), 10-19 years (**39**), 20-29 years (**139**), 30-39 (**190**) 40-49 (**155**) 50-59 (**109**) 60 years and above (**138**).

Today **293** patients have recovered from the disease with **322** are from the Home-Based Isolation and Care Program while **159** from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **184,461** out of whom **147,158** are from the Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **37,303** are from various health facilities.

Sadly, **15** patients have succumbed to the disease all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the months of April, June and July 2021. This now pushes the

cumulative fatalities to **3,826**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(2)**, 50-59 years **(2)**, 60 years and above **(10)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 **(121)**, 30-39 years **(313)**, 40-49 years **(455)**, 50-59 years **(766)**, 60 years and above **(2,089)**.

A total of **1,248** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **3,862** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **135** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **38** of whom are on ventilatory support and **70** on supplemental oxygen. **27** patients are under observation.

Another **356** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **320** of them in general wards and **36** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION:

As of July 21st 2021, a total of **1,648,869** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,042,455** while second doses are **606,414**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **58.2%** with the majority being males at **55%** while females are at **45%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **2.2%**.

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Aged 58 years and above **189,466**, Others **173,767**, Health Workers **108,874** Teachers **86,259** while Security Officers are at **48,048**.
