PRESS STATEMENT

Today **583** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,686** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **8.7%**. From the cases **561** are Kenyans while **22** are foreigners. **316** are males and **267** females. The youngest is a **five-month-old baby** while the oldest is **101** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **179,876** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,913,782**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **111**, Siaya **57**, Kisumu **51**, Kericho **46**, Mombasa **43**, Busia **39**, Nakuru **25**, Nyamira **24**,

Kakamega **21**, Homa Bay **20**, Vihiga **19**, Trans Nzoia **17**, Laikipia **12**, Kilifi **11**, Bungoma **11**, Makueni **10**, Nandi **9**, Kajiado **7**, Kiambu **7**, Bomet **5**, Machakos **5**, Taita Taveta **5**, Kisii **4**, Uasin Gishu **4**, Kwale **4**, Meru **3**, West Pokot **3**, Garissa **2**, Kirinyaga **1**, Kitui **1**, Migori **1**, Nyandarua **1**, Nyeri **1**, Turkana **1**, Isiolo **1** and Baringo **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **111** cases are from Kasarani (13), Langata and Starehe (10), Embakasi West and Roysambu (9) cases each, Makadara and Ruaraka (7) cases each, Dagoretti North, Kamukunji and Kibra (6) cases each, Embakasi South (5), Dagoretti South, Embakasi Central, Embakasi East, Embakasi North and Westlands (4) cases each, Mathare (3). In **Siaya** the **57** cases are from Alego-Usonga (34), Gem (11), Rarieda (5), Ugunja (4), Bondo (3).

In **Kisumu** the **51** cases are from Kisumu Central (30), Kisumu West (8), Muhoroni (5), Kisumu East (4), Nyakach and Nyando (2) cases each. In **Kericho** the **46** cases are from Ainamoi (15), Kipkelion East (12), Belgut (9), Sigowet/Soin (5), Kipkelion West (3), Bureti (2). In **Mombasa** the **43** cases are from Jomvu (13), Likoni (10), Mvita (8), Nyali (5), Kisauni (4), Changamwe (3). In **Busia** the **39** cases are from Matayos (22), Teso North (17).

In **Nakuru** the **25** cases are from Nakuru East and Nakuru West (7) cases each, Nakuru North and Rongai (3) cases each, Subukia (2), Kuresoi North, Molo and Njoro (1) case each. In **Nyamira** the **24** cases are from Manga (12), Borabu (9), Nyamira North (3). In **Kakamega** the **21** cases are from Lurambi (5), Mumias East (4), Shinyalu (3), Ikolomani, Khwisero and Mumias West (2) cases each, Butere, Likuyani and Malava (1) case each.

In **Homa Bay** the **20** cases are from Homa Bay Town (7), Karachuonyo (4), Suba North (3), Mbita and Rangwe (2) cases each, Ndhiwa and Rachuonyo South (1) case each. In **Vihiga** the **19** cases are from Hamisi and Sabatia (6) cases each, Vihiga (5), Luanda (2). In **Trans Nzoia** the **17** cases are from Kiminini (6), Saboti (5), Kwanza (4), Cherangany (2). In **Laikipia** the **12** cases are from Laikipia East (11), West (1).

In **Kilifi** the **11** cases are from Magarini and Malindi (4) cases each, Kaloleni (2), Kilifi North (1). In **Bungoma** the **11** cases are from Kanduyi (5), Sirisia (3), Bumula, Kabuchai and Kimilili (1) case each. In **Makueni** the **10** cases Makueni (4), Kaiti and Kilome (3) cases each. In **Nandi** the **9** cases are from Emgwen (3), Aldai and Nandi Hills (2) cases each, Chesumei and Mosop (1) case. In **Kajiado** the **7** cases are from Kajiado East (4), North (2), Loitokitok (1).

In **Kiambu** the **7** cases are from Kabete and Ruiru (2) cases each, Githunguri, Kiambaa and Kikuyu (1) case each. In **Bomet** the **5** cases are from Konoin (4), Chepalungu (1). In **Machakos** the **5** cases are from Masinga (3), Kalama and Machakos Town (1) case each. In **Taita Taveta** the **5** cases are from Voi (3), Mwatate and Taveta (1) case each. In **Kisii** the **4** cases are from Kitutu Chache South (2), Bobasi and Bonchari (1) case each.

In **Uasin Gishu** the **4** cases are from Ainabkoi, Kapseret, Kesses and Soy (1) case each. In **Kwale** the **4** cases are from Msambweni (3), Kinango (1). In **Meru** the **3** cases are from Buuri (2), Igembe Central (1). In **West Pokot** the **3** cases are from West Pokot while in **Garissa** the **2** cases are from Garissa Town.

The **case** in **Kirinyaga** is from Kirinyaga Central, the **case** in **Kitui** is from Kitui Rural, the **case** in **Migori** is from Uriri, the **case** in **Nyandarua** is from Ol kalou, the **case** in **Nyeri** is from Kieni East, the **case** in **Turkana** is from Turkana West, the **case** in **Isiolo** is from Isiolo Town and the **case** in **Baringo** is from Koibatek.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**16**), 10-19 years (**27**), 20-29 years (**89**), 30-39 (**136**) 40-49 (**103**) 50-59 (**100**) 60 years and above (**112**).

Today **85** patients have recovered from the disease, **60** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **25** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **123,050** of whom **89,192** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **33,858** are from various health facilities.

Unfortunately, **23** patients have succumbed to the disease all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility audit records in the month of June. The cumulative fatalities now stand at **3,484**. Our sincere condolences to all those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(3)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(18)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(55)**, 10-19 years **(25)**, 20-29 **(112)**, 30-39 years **(290)**, 40-49 years **(422)**, 50-59 years **(705)**, 60 years and above **(1,857)**.

A total of **1,098** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **5,669** patients are under Home Based

Isolation and Care program. **273** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **204** of whom are on ventilatory support and **51** on supplemental oxygen. **18** patients are under observation.

Another **123** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **113** of them in general wards and **10** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of today, a total of **1,190,889** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **996,414** while second doses are **194,475**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **19.5%** with the majority being males at **56%** while females are at **44%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is at **0.75%**

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Health Workers **52,916**, Aged 58 years and above **52,555**, Others **52,172**, Teachers **22,535** while Security Officers are at **14,297**.
