PRESS STATEMENT

Today **204** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,971** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **6.9%**. From the cases **198** are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **110** are males and **94** females. The youngest is a **two-month-old infant** while the oldest is **89** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **182,597** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,943,037**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **56**, Homa Bay **27**, Siaya **15**, Uasin Gishu **14**, Kisumu **12**, Kakamega **12**, Nakuru **9**, Bungoma **6**, Laikipia **6**, Kericho **6**, Kiambu **6**, Kajiado **5**, Nyeri **5**, Kilifi **4**, Nyandarua **4**, Meru **4**, Mombasa **3**, Murang'a **3**, Kisii **1**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Vihiga **1**, Baringo **1**, Bomet **1**, Busia **1** and Garissa **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **56** cases are from Embakasi East and Makadara (7) cases each, Starehe (5), Embakasi South, Embakasi West, Kibra, Langata, Ruaraka and Westlands (4) cases each, Dagoretti North and Mathare (3) cases each, Kamukunji and Kasarani (2) cases each, Dagoretti South, Embakasi Central and Embakasi North (1) case each. In **Homa Bay** the **27** cases are from Mbita (17), Rachuonyo South (4), Karachunyo (3), Homa Bay Town (2), Suba North (1).

In **Siaya** the **15** cases are from Alego-Usonga (12), Bondo, Rarieda, Ugenya (1) case each. In **Uasin Gishu** the **14** cases are from Turbo (5), Kapseret and Moiben (3) cases each, Ainabkoi (2), Kesses (1). In **Kisumu** the **12** cases are from Kisumu Central (7), Seme (3), Kisumu East and Kisumu West (1). In **Kakamega** the **12** cases are from Lurambi (7), Malava (3), Ikolomani and

Khwisero (1) case each. In **Nakuru** the **9** cases are from Naivasha (5), Subukia (2), Kuresoi North and Nakuru West (1) case each.

The **6** cases in **Bungoma** are from Kanduyi (4), Kimilili and Tongaren (1) case each, the **6** cases in **Laikipia** are all from Laikipia West, the **6** cases in **Kericho** are from Belgut (3), Bureti (2) and Kipkelion West (1), while the **6** cases in **Kiambu** are from Juja and Ruiru (6) cases each, Kiambaa and Kikuyu (1) case each. In **Kajiado** the **5** cases are from Loitokitok (4), Kajiado Central (1). In **Nyeri** all the **5** cases are from Nyeri Central. In **Kilifi** the **4** cases are from Malindi and in **Nyandarua** the **4** cases are from Oljororook while in **Meru** the **4** cases are from Imenti North.

In **Mombasa** the **3** cases are from Nyali (2) and Mvita (1). In **Murang'a** the **3** cases are from Mathioya (2) and Kiharu (1). The **case** in **Kisii** is from Bobasi, the **case** in **Trans Nzoia** is from Saboti, the **case** in **Vihiga** is from Hamisi, the **case** in **Baringo** is from Mogotio, the **case** in **Bomet** is from Konoin, the **case** in **Busia** is from Samia and the **case** in **Garissa** is from Dadaab.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**3**), 10-19 years (**11**), 20-29 years (**38**), 30-39 (**53**) 40-49 (**38**) 50-59 (**25**) 60 years and above (**36**).

Today **44** patients have recovered from the disease, **33** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **11** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **124,436** of whom **89,990** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **34,446** are from various health facilities.

Sadly, **21** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits on diverse dates in the months of May and June. The cumulative fatalities now stand at **3,595**. Our sincere condolences to all those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(1)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(2)**, 60 years and above **(16)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(55)**, 10-19 years **(25)**, 20-29 **(117)**, 30-39 years **(299)**, 40-49 years **(431)**, 50-59 years **(724)**, 60 years and above **(1,944)**.

A total of **1,051** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **6,760** patients are under Home Based

Isolation and Care program. **101** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **33** of whom are on ventilatory support and **53** on supplemental oxygen. **15** patients are under observation.

Another **114** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **105** of them in general wards and **9** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of 26th June 2021, a total of **1,287,776** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,002,499** while second doses are **285,277**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **28.5%** with the majority being males at **56%** while females are at **44%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **1.09%**

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Aged 58 years and above **83,526**, Others **76,962**, Health Workers **68,067**, Teachers **35,503** while Security Officers are at **21,219**.
