UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 28, 2021

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **287** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,699** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **10.6%**. From the cases **280** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **170** are males and **117** females. The youngest is a **three-month-old infant** while the oldest is **89** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **182,884** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,945,736**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **95**, Kajiado **56**, Kisii **35**, Siaya **17**, Homa Bay **17**, Kakamega **13**, Bungoma **11**, Busia **9**,

Uasin Gishu **9**, Nakuru **7**, Garissa **6**, Vihiga **4**, Kiambu **3**, Migori **2**, Nyeri **1**, Embu **1** and Kirinyaga **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **95** cases are from Langata (15), Kasarani (10), Kibra (9), Embakasi West and Starehe (7) cases each, Embakasi East, Embakasi South, Ruaraka and Westlands (6) cases each, Mathare and Roysambu (5) cases each, Dagoretti North and Embakasi North (3) cases each, Dagoretti South, Embakasi Central and Makadara (2) cases each, Kamukunji (1). In **Kajiado** the **56** cases are from Kajiado East (40), Kajiado North (16). In **Kisii** the **35** cases are from Kitutu Chacahe South (13), Nyaribari Chache (6), Bomachoge Chache and Kitutu Chache North (5) cases each, Bobasi (4).

In **Siaya** the **17** cases are from Alego-Usonga (15), Bondo and Gem (1) case each. In **Homa Bay** the **17** cases are from Rachuonyo South (10), Homa Bay Town (4), Mbita (2), Karachuonyo (1). In **Kakamega** the **13** cases are from Lurambi and Shinyalu (4) cases each, Ikolomani (3), Butere (1). In **Bungoma** the **11** cases are from from Webuye West (6), Kimilili (5). In **Busia** the cases are from Matayos (5), Teso North (4). In **Uasin Gishu** the **9** cases are from Moiben (3), Ainabkoi (2), Kapseret, Kesses, Soy and Turbo (1) case each.

In **Nakuru** the **7** cases are from Naivasha (4), Nakuru West, Nakuru East and Rongai (1) case each. In **Garissa** the **6** cases are from Garissa Town (5), Fafi (1). In **Vihiga** the **4** cases are from Vihiga (3), Sabatia (1). In **Kiambu** the **3** cases are from Juja, Kiambaa and Ruiru (1) case each. In **Migori** the **2** cases are from Suna East. The **case** in **Nyeri** is from Tetu, the **case** in **Embu** is from Manyatta and the **case** in **Kirinyaga** is from Mwea West.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**13**), 10-19 years (**48**), 20-29 years (**37**), 30-39 (**69**) 40-49 (**34**) 50-59 (**35**) 60 years and above (**51**).

Today **152** patients have recovered from the disease, **84** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **68** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **124,588** out of whom **90,074** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **34,514** are from various health facilities.

Unfortunately, **17** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits on diverse dates in the months of April, May and June. The

cumulative fatalities now stand at **3,612**. Our sincere condolences to all those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(2)**, 40-49 years **(2)**, 50-59 years **(3)**, 60 years and above **(9)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(25)**, 20-29 **(117)**, 30-39 years **(301)**, 40-49 years **(433)**, 50-59 years **(727)**, 60 years and above **(1,953)**.

A total of **1,062** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **6,730** patients are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **101** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **33** of whom are on ventilatory support and **45** on supplemental oxygen. **23** patients are under observation.

Another **116** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **102** of them in general wards and **14** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of today, a total of **1,293,004** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,003,204** while second doses are **289,800**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **28.9%** with the majority being males at **56%** while females are at **44%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **1.11%**

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Aged 58 years and above **84,855**, Others **78,309**, Health Workers **68,688**, Teachers **36,167** while Security Officers are at **21,781**.
