**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **719** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **7,608** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **9.5%**. From the cases **666** are Kenyans while **53** are foreigners. **435** are males and **284** females. The youngest is a **one-year-old infant** while the oldest is **93** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **183,603** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,953,344**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **188**, Busia **76**, Kisii **57**, Siaya **53**, Kisumu **38**, Kilifi **38**, Uasin Gishu **29**, Kakamega **26**, Nakuru **23**, Vihiga **22**, Mombasa **17**, Bungoma **16**, Homa Bay **15**, Machakos **14**, Kericho **13**, Turkana **13**, Nandi **11**, Kiambu **11**, Laikipia **10**, Taita Taveta **7**, Embu **6**, Kajiado **6**, Nyamira **5**, Kwale **4**, Makueni **4**, Trans Nzoia **3**, Nyeri **2**, Kirinyaga **2**, Kitui **2**, Migori **2**, Narok **1**, Nyandarua **1**, Garissa **1**, Isiolo **1**, Meru **1** and Bomet **1**.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **188** cases are from Westlands (24), Dagoretti North (22), Kasarani (15), Embakasi West and Kibra (2) cases each, Embakasi South, Makadara and Roysambu (11) cases each, Kamukunji, Mathare and Starehe (10) cases each, Langata and Ruaraka (8) cases each, Embakasi Central and Embakasi East (7) cases each, Dagoretti South and Embakasi North (5) cases each. In **Busia** the **76** cases are from Matayos (45), Teso North (18), Teso South (6), Bunyala (3), Butula and Samia (2) cases each.

In **Kisii** the **57** cases are from Kitutu Chache South (28), Nyaribari Chache (9), Bomachoge Borabu and Bonchari (6) cases each, Bomachoge Chache (5), Bobasi (2), South Mugirango (1). In **Siaya** the **53** cases are from Alego-Usonga (25), Gem (15), Bondo (8),

Ugunja (3), Ugenya (2). In **Kisumu** the **38** cases are from Kisumu Central (25), Kisumu East, Muhoroni and Nyakach (3) cases each, Kisumu West (2), Nyando and Seme (1) case each. In **Kilifi** the **38** cases are from Magarini (27), Malindi (6), Kilifi North (3), Kaloleni (2). In **Uasin Gishu** the **29** cases are from Turbo (11), Ainabkoi (9), Kesses (4), Moiben (3), Kapseret and Soy (1) case each. In **Kakamega** the **26** cases are from Lurambi (8), Shinyalu (7), Ikolomani and Mumias West (3) cases each, Lugari (2), Butere, Kwhisero and Likuyani (1) case each.

In **Nakuru** the **23** cases are from Nakuru West (15), Nakuru East (5) and Rongai (3). In **Vihiga** the **22** cases are from Luanda (10), Vihiga (7), Sabatia (3), Emuhaya and Khwisero (1) case each. In **Mombasa** the **17** cases are from Changamwe and Kisauni (5) cases each, Jomvu, Mvita and Nyali (2) cases each, Likoni (1). In **Bungoma** the **16** cases are from Kimilili (10), Webuye West (4), Kanduyi (2). In **Homa Bay** the **15** cases are from Homa Bay Town (9), Suba North (2), Karachuonyo, Mbita, Ndhiwa and Rangwe (1) case each.

In **Machakos** the **14** cases are from Masinga (8), Machakos Town (3), Matungulu (2), Yatta (1). In **Kericho** the **13** cases are from Belgut (6), Ainamoi (5), Sigowet/Soin (2). In **Turkana** all the **13** cases are from Turkana West. In **Nandi** the **11** cases are from

Nandi Hills (4), Chesumei and Emgwen (2) cases each, Aldai, Chepalungu and Mosop (1) case each.

In **Kiambu** the **11** cases are from Lari (3), Juja (2), Gatundu North, Kabete, Kiambaa, Kiambu Town, Kikuyu and Ruiru (1) case each.

In **Laikipia** all the **10** cases are from Laikipia West, while in **Taita Taveta** all the **7** cases are from Voi. In **Embu** the **6** cases are from Manyatta (5), Runyenjes (1). In **Kajiado** the **6** cases are from Kajiado East (3), Rongai (2), Kajiado North (1). In **Nyamira** the **5** cases are from Manga (4), Masaba North (1). In **Kwale** the **4** cases are from Msambweni (3), Matuga (1). In **Makueni** the **4** cases are from Kilome (3), Makueni (1). In **Trans Nzoia** the **3** cases are from Kiminini.

The **2** cases in **Nyeri** are from Mathira West and Mukurweini (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Kirinyaga** are from Mwea West, the **2** cases in **Kitui** are from Kitui Central and West (1) case each and the **2** cases in **Migori** are from Nyatike and Rongo (1) case each. The **case** in **Narok** is from Narok North, the **case** in **Nyandarua** is from Kipipiri, the **case** in **Garissa** is from Garissa Town, the **case** in **Isiolo** is from Merti, the **case** in **Meru** is from Buuri and the **case** in **Bomet** is from Bomet Central.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(25)**, 10-19 years **(51)**, 20-29 years **(127)**, 30-39 **(190)** 40-49 **(106)** 50-59 **(101)** 60 years and above **(119)**.

Today **800** patients have recovered from the disease, **695** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **105** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **125,388** out of whom **90,769** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **34,619** are from various health facilities.

Sadly, **9** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits on diverse dates in the months of October and December 2020, April and June 2021. The cumulative fatalities now stand at **3,621**. Our sincere condolences to all those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(8)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**56**), 10-19 years (**26**), 20-29 (**117**), 30-39 years (**301**), 40-49 years (**433**), 50-59 years (**727**), 60 years and above (**1,961**).

A total of **1,088** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **6,465** patients are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **112** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **35** of whom are on ventilatory support and **47** on supplemental oxygen. **30** patients are under observation.

Another **129** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **112** of them in general wards and **17** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

**VACCINATION:** As of today, a total of **1,334,749** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,005,901** while second doses are **328,848**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **32.7%** with the majority being males at **55%** while females are at **45%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **1.26%**.

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows:  
Aged 58 years and above **100,016**, Others **87,923**, Health  
Workers **74,173**, Teachers **42,114** while Security Officers are at  
**24,622**.
