UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 5, 2021

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **185** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,047** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **9.0%**. From the cases **171** are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **112** are males and **73** females. The youngest is a **five-year-old child** while the oldest is **91** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **186,053** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,983,998**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **94**, Bungoma **25**, Mombasa **16**, Machakos **11**, Kakamega **7**, Tana River **5**, Kilifi **5**,

Kiambu **4**, Homa Bay **3**, Kajiado **3**, Nakuru **3**, Murang'a **2**, Kericho **2**, Kisii **1**, Kwale **1**, Makueni **1**, Meru **1** and Tharaka Nithi **1**.

In terms of Sub County distribution; the **94** cases in **Nairobi** are from Embakasi East, Embakasi West and Ruaraka (9) cases each, Makadara and Roysambu (7) cases each, Dagoretti South, Mathare and Starehe (6) cases each, Kamukunji and Westlands (5) cases each, Dagoretti North, Embakasi Central, Kasarani and Langata (4) cases each, Embakasi South, Embakasi North and Kibra (3) cases each. In **Bungoma** the **25** cases are from Kimilili (10), Mt. Elgon (5), Webuye East and Webuye West (4) cases each, Kabuchai and Tongaren (1) case each.

In **Mombasa** the **16** cases are from Mvita (7), Kisauni (3), Changamwe and Nyali (2) cases each, Jomvu and Likoni (1) case each. In **Machakos** the **11** cases are from Matungulu (4), Masinga and Yatta (2) cases each, Athi River, Kalama and Kangundo (1) case each. In **Kakamega** all the **7** cases are from Lurambi. In **Tana River** all the **5** cases are from Galole, while in **Kilifi** the **5** cases are from Malindi (3), Kaloleni and Kilifi North (1) case each. In **Kiambu** the **4** cases are from Kiambaa (2), Limuru and Ruiru (1) case each.

The **3** cases in **Homa Bay** are from Karachuonyo (2), Rangwe (1), the **3** cases in **Kajiado** are from Kajiado North (2), Kajiado East (1) while the **3** cases in **Nakuru** are from Nakuru East. The **2** cases in **Murang'a** are from Kangema and Mathioya (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Kericho** are from Kipkelion East. The **case** in **Kisii** is from Nyaribari Chache, the **case** in **Kwale** is from Msambweni, the **case** in **Makueni** is from Kaiti, the **case** in **Meru** is from Imenti South and the **case** in **Tharaka Nithi** is from Mwimbi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**19**), 20-29 years (**23**), 30-39 (**46**) 40-49 (**36**) 50-59 (**32**) 60 years and above (**27**).

Today **1,186** patients have recovered from the disease, **1,102** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **84** from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **128,811** out of which **93,391** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **35,420** are from various health facilities.

Sadly, **15** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting Facility Record Audits on diverse dates in the month of June 2021. The cumulative

fatalities now stand at **3,690**. Our sincere condolences to all those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(3)**, 50-59 years **(2)**, 60 years and above **(9)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 **(118)**, 30-39 years **(305)**, 40-49 years **(442)**, 50-59 years **(745)**, 60 years and above **(1,998)**.

A total of **1,151** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **5,426** patients are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **119** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **33** of whom are on ventilatory support and **47** on supplemental oxygen. **39** patients are under observation.

Another **182** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **161** of them in general wards and **21** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of today, a total of **1,477,916** vaccines have so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,018,143** while second doses are **459,773**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **45.2%** with the majority being males at **55%** while females are at **45%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **1.77%**.

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Aged 58 years and above **142,676**, Others **128,004**, Health Workers **90,954**, Teachers **62,724** while Security Officers are at **35,415**.
