### **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 6, 2021**

#### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **400** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,068** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **7.9%**. From the cases **386** are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **220** are males and **180** females. The youngest is a **12-day-old infant** while the oldest is **97** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **186,453** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,989,066**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **155**, Kilifi **43**, Uasin Gishu **34**, Siaya **21**, Kiambu **19**, Busia **18**, Mombasa **16**, Kisumu **13**,

Nyamira **11**, Nakuru **11**, Narok **6**, Kwale **5**, Marsabit **5**, Murang'a **5**, Nyandarua **4**, Nyeri **4**, Kisii **4**, Homa Bay **4**, Bomet **3**, Kajiado **3**, Kakamega **3**, Kitui **3**, Kericho **2**, Migori **2**, Machakos **1**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Embu **1**, Turkana **1**, West Pokot **1** and Garissa **1**.

In terms of Sub County distribution; the **155** cases in **Nairobi** are from Kibra and Westlands (15) cases each, Dagoretti North (14), Embakasi Central and Roysambu (12) cases each, Makadara, Ruaraka and Starehe (11) cases each, Dagoretti South and Kasarani (8) cases each, Kamukunji and Mathare (7) cases each, Embakasi West (6), Embakasi North and Embakasi South (5) cases each, Embakasi East and Langata (4) cases each. In **Kilifi** the **43** cases are from Magarini (28), Malindi (8), Kaloleni and Rabai (3) cases each, Kilifi North (1).

In **Uasin Gishu** the **34** cases are from Ainabkoi (12), Turbo (8), Kapseret and Kesses (5) cases each, Moiben (3), Soy (1). In **Siaya** the **21** cases are from Alego-Usonga (8), Gem (6), Ugenya (4), Bondo (2), Rarieda (1). In **Kiambu** the **19** cases are from Ruiru (11), Juja and Kikuyu (3) cases each, Kabete and Kiambu Town (1) case each. In **Busia** the **18** cases are from Matayos (10), Teso

South (7), North (1). In **Mombasa** the **16** cases are from Mvita (10), Kisauni (3), Nyali (2), Likoni (1).

In **Kisumu** the **13** cases are from Kisumu Central (7), Kisumu East and Nyando (2) cases each, Muhoroni and Seme (1) case each. In **Nyamira** the **11** cases are from Nyamira North (6), Manga (5). In **Nakuru** the **11** cases are from Naivasha (6), Gilgil, Molo, Nakuru East, Nakuru West and Njoro (1) case each. In **Narok** all the **6** cases are from Narok North. In **Kwale** the **5** cases are from Kinango (3), Matuga and Msambweni (1) case each. In **Marsabit** the **5** cases are from Saku (3), Moyale and North Horr (1) case each. In **Murang'a** the **5** cases are from Kiharu.

The **4** cases in **Nyandarua** are from Ndaragwa and Olkalou (2) cases each, the **4** cases in **Nyeri** are from Kieni West, Mathira East, Mathira West and Mukurweini (1) case each, the **4** cases in **Kisii** are from Kitutu Chache North (3), Bomachoge Chache (1) and the **4** cases in **Homa Bay** are from Homa Bay Town, Mbita, Ndhiwa and Rachuonyo South (1) case each.

The **3** cases in **Bomet** are from Konoin, the **3** cases in **Kajiado** are from Kajiado North (2), Kajiado East (1), the **3** cases in **Kakamega** are from Lurambi (2), Ikolomani (1) while the **3** cases in **Kitui** are from Mwingi West. In **Kericho** the **2** cases are from Belgut. In **Migori** the **2** cases are from Kuria West and Nyatike (1)

case each. The **case** in **Machakos** is from Machakos Town, the **case** in **Trans Nzoia** is from Kwanza, the **case** in **Turkana** is from Turkana West, the **case** in **West Pokot** is from Pokot South and the **case** in **Garissa** is from Dadaab.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(10)**, 10-19 years **(25)**, 20-29 years **(84)**, 30-39 **(99)** 40-49 **(67)** 50-59 **(51)** 60 years and above **(64)**.

Today **354** patients have recovered from the disease, **259** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **95** from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **129,165** out of whom **93,650** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **35,515** are from various health facilities.

Unfortunately, **7** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits on diverse dates in the month of June 2021. The cumulative fatalities now stand at **3,697**. Our sincere condolences to all those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(2)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(56)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 **(118)**, 30-39 years **(305)**, 40-49 years **(442)**, 50-59 years **(747)**, 60 years and above **(2,003)**.

A total of **1,133** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **5,387** patients are under the Home Based Isolation and Care program. **113** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **30** of whom are on ventilatory support and **46** on supplemental oxygen. **37** patients are under observation.

Another **185** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **163** of them in general wards and **22** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

**VACCINATION:** As of today, a total of **1,495,120** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses are **1,020,120** while second doses are **475,000**. The

uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose is at **46.6%** with the majority being males at **55%** while females are at **45%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated is **1.8%**.

The uptake of the second dose by Priority Groups is as follows: Aged 58 years and above **147,263**, Others **132,754**, Health Workers **92,915**, Teachers **65,125** while Security Officers are at **36,943**.
