UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 7, 2021

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **148** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,163** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now **6.8%**. From the cases **144** are Kenyans while **4** are foreigners. **79** are males and **69** females. The youngest is a **one-year-old baby** while the oldest is **87** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **172,639** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **1,836,410**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **48**, Homa Bay **46**, Mombasa **8**, Uasin Gishu **7**, Machakos **6**, Kisumu **5**, Nakuru **4**,

Kiambu **4**, Kilifi **3**, Kajiado **2**, Marsabit **2**, Nandi **2**, Tharaka Nithi **2**, Narok, Trans Nzoia, Kisii, Laikipia, Turkana, Baringo, Bomet, Busia and Embu **1** cases each.

In terms of **Sub County** distribution; In **Nairobi** the **48** cases are from Embakasi West and Westlands (5) cases each, Embakasi North, Kasarani and Starehe (4) cases each, Dagoretti North, Embakasi Central, Mathare and Roysambu (3) cases each, Dagoretti South, Embakasi East, Kamukunji, Langata, Makadara and Ruaraka (2) cases each, Embakasi South and Kibra (1) case each. In **Homa Bay** the **46** cases are from Homa Bay Town (24), Karachuonyo (8), Rachuonyo South (5), Rangwe (4), Ndiwa (3), Suba North (2).

In **Mombasa** the **8** cases are from Jomvu (3), Kisauni and Mvita (2) cases each, Nyali (1). In **Uasin Gishu** the **7** cases are from Soy (3), Kapseret (2), Kesses and Moiben (1) case each. In **Machakos** the **6** cases are from Masinga (3), Athi River, Kalama and Yatta (1) case each. In **Kisumu** all the **5** cases are from Kisumu Central. In **Nakuru** the **4** cases are from Naivasha (3), Nakuru East (1). In **Kiambu** the **4** cases are from Kiambaa, Kiambu Town, Ruiru and Thika (1) case each. In **Kilifi** the **3** cases are from Magarini (2), Malindi (1).

The **2** cases in **Kajiado** are from Kajiado East and Kajiado North (1) case each, the **2** cases in **Marsabit** are from Saku, the **2** cases in **Nandi** are from Emgwen and Nandi Hills (1) case each and the **2** cases in **Tharaka Nithi** are from Tharaka South.

The **case** in **Narok** is from Narok North, the **case** in **Trans Nzoia** is from Kwanza, the **case** in **Kisii** is from Bonchari, the **case** in **Laikipia** is from Laikipia East, the **case** in **Turkana** is from Turkana Central, the **case** in **Baringo** is from Baringo Central, the **case** in **Bomet** is from Sotik, the **case** in **Busia** is from Butula and the **case** in **Embu** is from Manyatta.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**7**), 10-19 years (**9**), 20-29 years (**7**), 30-39 (**32**) 40-49 (**21**) 50-59 (**27**) 60 years and above (**45**).

Today **631** patients have recovered from the disease, **496** from the Home Based and Isolation Care program while **135** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **118,226** of whom **85,892** are from Home Based Care and Isolation program, while **32,334** are from various health facilities.

Unfortunately, **21** people have been reported to succumb to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting Facility Record Audits on diverse dates in the month of April and May. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **3,308**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years (**0**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 (**0**), 30-39 years (**2**), 40-49 years (**1**), 50-59 years (**4**), 60 years and above (**13**).

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**54**), 10-19 years (**23**), 20-29 (**110**), 30-39 years (**268**), 40-49 years (**409**), 50-59 years (**686**), 60 years and above (**1,758**).

A total of **1,147** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **4,802** patients are under Home Based Isolation and Care program. **102** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **26** of whom are on ventilatory support and **60** on supplemental oxygen. **16** patients are under observation.

Another **95** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **88** of them in general wards and **7** in High Dependency Units (HDU).

VACCINATION: As of today, a total of **975,835** persons have so far been vaccinated against the COVID-19 disease countrywide. Of these **295,660** are aged 58 years and above, Others **277,953**, Health workers **166,304**, Teachers **153,145**, while Security Officers **82,773**.

SECOND DOSE: As of today, a total of **13,194** have been vaccinated their second dose. Of these **6,337** are Health Workers, Others **2,575**, aged 58 years and above **2,411**, Teachers **1,161** while Security Officers **714**.
