Table 4 above, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of dose 2 uptake. Nairobi County in the lead with 8.7% of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 6.3%, Uasin Gishu with 4.8% Laikipia 4.4%, Nyandarua 4.2%, Nakuru 4.0%, while Marsabit, is the least with 0.3%, of the population fully vaccinated.
