PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of September 28th, 2021, a total of **3,712,030** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses were **2,813,477** while second doses were **898,553**. The uptake

of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **31.9%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **3.3%**.

The Government is working towards vaccinating targeted population of **27,246,033**. A total of **2,813,477** persons have so far been vaccinated for the first dose. The following county figures represent those vaccinated in respective counties and percentage of the population in that area as follows;

On the other hand, for the second dose a total of **898,553** persons have so far been fully vaccinated out of the targeted **27,246,033** for this phase. In terms of Country distribution was as follows;

On the Covid-19 situation today **404** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,309** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **6.4 %**. From the cases **390** of them are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **206** males while **198** are females. The youngest is a **6-day-old infant** while the oldest is **106** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **249,174** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,549,996**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **66**, Nakuru **47**, Nyamira **45**, Kisii **28**, Siaya **20**, Uasin Gishu **19**, Nyandarua **17**, Kericho **17**, Kitui **15**, Migori **15**, Kiambu **13**, Meru **13**, Garissa **9**, Embu **8**, Mombasa **8**, Kakamega **7**, Kajiado **7**, Kirinyaga **6**, Tharaka Nithi **5**,

Homa Bay **5**, Machakos **4**, Murang'a **4**, Nandi **3**, Bomet **3**, Busia **3**, Kisumu **3**, Isiolo **2**, Kilifi **2**, Laikipia **2**, Nyeri **2**, Turkana **2**, Kwale **1**, Tana River **1**, West Pokot **1** and Bungoma **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**10**), 10-19 years (**27**), 20-29 years (**64**), 30-39 (**83**), 40-49 (**58**), 50-59 (**53**), 60 years and above (**109**).

Today **231** patients have recovered from the disease with **159** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **72** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **241,411** of whom **195,209** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **46,202** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, **one** of them having occurred in the last 24 hours while **two** are late deaths

reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of September 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,119**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(57)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(139)**, 30-39 years **(372)**, 40-49 years **(596)**, 50-59 years **(963)** 60 years and above **(2,954)**.

A total of **1,042** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **2,247** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **75** patients are in the Intensive Care

Unit (ICU), **46** of whom are on ventilatory support and **29** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **336** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **324** of them in general wards and **12** in High Dependency Units (HDU).
