PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of September 29th, 2021, a total of **3,761,876** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses were **2,856,972** while second doses were **904,904**. The uptake

of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **31.7%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **3.3%**.

The Government is working towards vaccinating targeted population of **27,246,033**. A total of **2,856,972** persons have so far been vaccinated for the first dose. The following county figures represent those vaccinated in respective counties and percentage of the population in that area as follows;

On the other hand, for the second dose a total of **904,904** persons have so far been fully vaccinated out of the targeted **27,246,033** for this phase. In terms of Country distribution was as follows;

On the Covid-19 situation today **260** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,226** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **4.2 %**. From the cases **256** of them are Kenyans while **4** are foreigners. **140** males while **120** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **99** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **249,434** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,556,222**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **63**, Kajiado **19**, Kitui **16**, Kiambu **15**, Nakuru **13**, Uasin Gishu **11**, Meru **11**, Wajir **11**, Bungoma **8**, Garissa **6**, Mombasa **6**, Homa Bay **5**, Kericho **5**, Makueni **5**, Nandi **5**, Nyandarua **5**, Bomet **4**, Laikipia **4**, Kirinyaga

4, Embu **4**, Machakos **3**, Kakamega **3**, Kisumu **3**, Murang'a **3**, Tharaka Nithi **3**, Samburu **3**, West Pokot **3**, Siaya **2**, Busia **2**, Isiolo **2**, Taita Taveta **2**, Turkana **2**, Vihiga **2**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Kilifi **1**, Kisii **1**, Migori **1**, Narok **1**, Nyeri **1** and Trans Nzoia **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**11**), 10-19 years (**10**), 20-29 years (**40**), 30-39 (**45**), 40-49 (**41**), 50-59 (**47**), 60 years and above (**66**).

Today **109** patients have recovered from the disease with **78** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **31** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **241,520** of whom **195,287** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **46,233** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **4** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of September 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,123**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years (**0**), 10-19 years (**0**), 20-29 (**0**), 30-39 years (**0**), 40-49 years (**0**), 50-59 years (**1**), 60 years and above (**3**).

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**57**), 10-19 years (**38**), 20-29 (**139**), 30-39 years (**372**), 40-49 years (**596**), 50-59 years (**964**) 60 years and above (**2,957**).

A total of **1,021** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **2,193** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **66** patients are in the Intensive Care

Unit (ICU), **45** of whom are on ventilatory support and **21** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **336** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **324** of them in general wards and **12** in High Dependency Units (HDU).
