## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

#### **VACCINATION:**

As of October 9<sup>th</sup> 2021, a total of **4,183,552** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,135,700** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,047,852**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **33.4%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **3.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**. The table below shows the proportion of those above 18 years who are partially vaccinated in respective counties. Nairobi County is the highest with **30.7 %** of its population receiving the first dose while Marsabit is the least with **1.3%**.

The table below shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **12.6%** of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **9.5%** Uasin Gishu with **5.9%** Laikipia **4.8%**, Nyandarua **4.6%**, Nakuru **4.2%**, while Marsabit, is the least with **0.4%**, of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **95** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,334** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.9%**. From the cases **86** are Kenyans while **9** are foreigners. **56** are males while **39** are females. The youngest is a **one-month-old infant** while the oldest is **95** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **251,152** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,606,152**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nyamira **14**, Nairobi **11**, Nakuru **10**, Garissa **9**, Nyeri **9**, Turkana **7**, Kiambu **5**, Marsabit **4**, Kisii **4**, Machakos **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Kitui **2**, Kakamega **2**, Laikipia **2**, Bomet **1**, Busia **1**, Embu **1**, Kirinyaga **1**, Murang'a **1**, Nandi **1**, Narok **1**, Nyandarua **1**, Siaya **1** and West Pokot **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(13)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(13)**, 30-39 **(25)**, 40-49 **(13)**, 50-59 **(10)**, 60 years and above **(18)**.

Today **172** patients have recovered from the disease with **138** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **34** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **243,944** of whom **197,180** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **46,764** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, today there are no deaths reported. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities still remain at **5,181**.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(140)**, 30-39 years **(375)**, 40-49 years **(599)**, 50-59 years **(974)** 60 years and above **(2,997)**.

A total of **762** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,788** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **47** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **31** of whom are on ventilatory support and **16** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **256** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **250** of them in general wards and **6** in High Dependency Units (HDU).
