PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of October 13th 2021, a total of **4,340,511** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,213,661** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,126,850**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **33.6%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **4.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the proportion of those above 18 years who are partially vaccinated in respective counties. Nairobi County is the highest with **31.2%** of its population receiving the first dose while Marsabit County is the least with **1.3%**.

The table below shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **13.4%** of its population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **10.5%**, Uasin Gishu with **6.3%**, Kiambu **6.0%**, Nyandarua **5.2%**, Kisumu **5.0%** while Marsabit, is the least with **0.4%**, of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **186** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,965** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.7%**. From the cases **179** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **99** males while **87** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **91** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **251,669** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,624,665**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Trans Nzoia **20**, Nakuru **19**, Nairobi **17**, Marsabit **14**, Murang'a **11**, Meru **10**, Kisii **9**, Uasin Gishu **8**, Kiambu **6**, Bungoma **5**, Makueni **5**, Baringo **5**, Isiolo **5**, Tharaka Nithi **5**, Turkana **4**, West Pokot **4**, Kericho **4**, Bomet **4**, Kwale **4**, Garissa **4**, Embu **3**, Kirinyaga **3**, Nyandarua **3**, Kilifi **2**, Nyeri **2**, Siaya **2**, Busia **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kakamega **1**, Kitui **1**, Laikipia **1**, Machakos **1** and Mombasa **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(6)**, 10-19 years **(10)**, 20-29 years **(32)**, 30-39 **(44)**, 40-49 **(32)**, 50-59 **(17)**, 60 years and above **(45)**.

Today **189** patients have recovered from the disease with **135** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **54** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Total recoveries now stand at **244,935** of whom **197,907** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,028** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **4** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the months of September and October 2021. This now pushes the cumulative deaths to **5,202**. Our sincere condolences to the families and those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(140)**, 30-39 years **(376)**, 40-49 years **(602)**, 50-59 years **(978)** 60 years and above **(3,010)**.

A total of **640** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,631** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **35** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **18** of whom are on ventilatory support and **17** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **211** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **207** of them in general wards and **4** in High Dependency Units (HDU).
