PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of September 30th, 2021, a total of **3,811,136** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, total first doses were **2,897,007** while second doses were **914,129**. The uptake

of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **31.6%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **3.4%**.

The Government is working towards vaccinating targeted population of **27,246,033**. A total of **2,897,007** persons have so far been vaccinated for the first dose. The following county figures represent those vaccinated in respective counties and percentage of the population in that area as follows;

On the other hand, for the second dose a total of **914,129** persons have so far been fully vaccinated out of the targeted **27,246,033** for this phase. In terms of Country distribution was as follows;

On the Covid-19 situation today **291** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,501** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **4.5 %**. From the cases **282** of them are Kenyans while **9** are foreigners. **160** males while **131** are females. The youngest is a **five-month-old baby** while the oldest is **100** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **249,725** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,562,723**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **80**, Makueni **36**, Murang'a **25**, Nakuru **18**, Meru **13**, Kisii **13**, Uasin Gishu **9**, Marsabit **8**, Machakos **7**, Kericho **6**, Busia **6**, Laikipia **6**, Turkana **5**, Bungoma **5**, Garissa **5**, Kirinyaga **4**, Mombasa **4**, Narok **4**, Nyeri **4**, Siaya **4**,

Kajiado **3**, Kiambu **3**, Nandi **3**, Kitui **3**, Embu **2**, Baringo **2**, Kakamega **2**, Lamu **2**, Tharaka Nithi **2**, Vihiga **1**, West Pokot **1**, Kisumu **1**, Kilifi **1**, Migori **1**, Nyandarua **1** and Tana River **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**12**), 10-19 years (**14**), 20-29 years (**60**), 30-39 (**50**), 40-49 (**56**), 50-59 (**36**), 60 years and above (**63**).

Today **308** patients have recovered from the disease with **208** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **100** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **241,828** of whom **195,495** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **46,333** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **5** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the

month of September 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,128**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(2)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(57)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(139)**, 30-39 years **(374)**, 40-49 years **(596)**, 50-59 years **(964)** 60 years and above **(2,960)**.

A total of **963** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **2,078** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **61** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **39** of whom are on ventilatory support and **21** on supplemental oxygen. **One** patient is under observation.

Another **315** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **306** of them in general wards and **9** in High Dependency Units (HDU).
