**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of October 22<sup>nd</sup> 2021, a total of **4,902, 772** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,493,570** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,414,202**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **38.5%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **5.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **16.2%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri County **13.9%**, Kiambu **8.2%**, Uasin Gishu with **7.6%**, Nyandarua **7.1%**, Kisumu **6.5%**, Mombasa **6.2%**, while Lamu, Mandera, Wajir, Garissa, and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

county is on the lead with **32.9%** of its population receiving the first dose while Marsabit County is the least with **1.4%** of the population having received the first dose.

On the Covid-19 situation today **129** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **5,110** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.5%**. From the cases **117** are Kenyans while **12** are foreigners. **80** males while **49** are females. The youngest is a **three-year-old child** while the oldest is **82** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **252,628** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,669,467**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **20**, Trans Nzoia **16**, Uasin Gishu **14**, Nakuru **13**, Turkana **10**, Kericho **8**, Meru **6**, Mombasa **5**, Kajiado **5**, West Pokot **4**, Siaya **3**, Kiambu **3**, Kisii **3**, Baringo **2**, Homa Bay **2**, Narok **2**, Bomet **1**, Busia **1**, Garissa **1**, Murang'a **1**,

Kakamega **1**, Nyeri **1**, Kitui **1**, Isiolo **1**, Migori **1**, Kwale **1**, Laikipia **1**, Lamu **1** and Machakos **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**5**), 10-19 years (**8**), 20-29 years (**23**), 30-39 (**29**), 40-49 (**23**), 50-59 (**18**), 60 years and above (**23**).

Today **65** patients have recovered from the disease with **49** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **16** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **246,027** of whom **198,748** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,279** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **6** patients have succumbed to the disease, **one** in the last 24 hours while the other **5** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the months of August and

October 2021. This now pushes the cumulative deaths to **5,255**. Our sincere condolences to the families and those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(1)**, 40-49 years **(1)**, 50-59 years **(1)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(141)**, 30-39 years **(379)**, 40-49 years **(609)**, 50-59 years **(985)** 60 years and above **(3,045)**.

A total of **521** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,429** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **30** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **13** of whom are on ventilatory support and **17** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **164** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **156** of them in the general wards. **8** patients are in the High Dependency Units (HDU).
