**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of October 25<sup>th</sup> 2021, a total of **5,029,901** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,545,060** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,484,841**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **39.8%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **5.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **16.8%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri County **14.7%**, Kiambu **8.6%**, Uasin Gishu with **7.7%**, Nyandarua **7.4%**, Kisumu **6.9%**, Mombasa **6.5%**, while West Pokot, Mandera, Wajir, Garissa, and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **151** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **7,224** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.1%**. From the cases **141** are Kenyans while **10** are foreigners. **84** males while **67** are females. The youngest is a **one-year-old child** while the oldest is **113** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **252,839** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,682,247**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **30**, Bomet **18**, Meru **17**, Makueni **13**, Nakuru **9**, Kericho **8**, Bungoma **7**, Kisii **5**, Kajiado **5**, Kisumu **4**, Mombasa **4**, Narok **4**, Kakamega **3**, Nyeri **3**, West Pokot **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Kiambu **3**, Marsabit **2**, Nyandarua **2**, Garissa **2**,

Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Laikipia **1**, Vihiga **1**, Machakos **1**, Murang'a **1** and Migori **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**6**), 10-19 years (**8**), 20-29 years (**19**), 30-39 (**41**), 40-49 (**18**), 50-59 (**23**), 60 years and above (**36**).

Today **35** patients have recovered from the disease with **25** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **10** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **246,390** of whom **199,044** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,346** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the months of July and October 2021. This now pushes

the cumulative deaths to **5,263**. Our sincere condolences to the families and those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(141)**, 30-39 years **(379)**, 40-49 years **(610)**, 50-59 years **(985)** 60 years and above **(3,052)**.

A total of **488** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,308** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **27** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **13** of whom are on ventilatory support and **14** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **157** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **149** of them in the general wards. **8** patients are in the High Dependency Units (HDU).
