PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of October 26th 2021, a total of **5,084, 297** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,576,875** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,507,422**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **40.0%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **5.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **16.9%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county **14.8%**, Kiambu **8.7%**, Uasin Gishu with **7.8%**, Nyandarua **7.4%**, Kisumu **7.0%**, Mombasa **6.6%**, while West Pokot, Mandera, Wajir, Garissa, and Marsabit are the least counties with less than **1%** of the population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **99** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,895** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.0%**. From the cases **98** are Kenyans except **1** is a foreigner. **61** males while **38** are females. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **89** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **252,938** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,687,142**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **18**, Nakuru **18**, Meru **14**, Kakamega **5**, Kiambu **4**, Embu **4**, Garissa **4**, Nyeri **3**, Tharaka Nithi **3**, Kisii **3**, Marsabit **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kajiado **2**, Nyandarua **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Busia **2**, Baringo **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Makueni **1**, Machakos **1**, Migori **1**, Kericho **1**, Murang'a **1**, Trans Nzoia **1**, Taita Taveta **1**, Tana River **1** and Vihiga **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(6)**, 20-29 years **(16)**, 30-39 **(24)**, 40-49 **(15)**, 50-59 **(11)**, 60 years and above **(25)**.

Today **115** patients have recovered from the disease with **77** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **38** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **246,505** of whom **199,121** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,384** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility audit records in July and October 2021. This now pushes the cumulative deaths to **5,266**. Our sincere condolences to the families and those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(0)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(141)**, 30-39 years **(379)**, 40-49 years **(610)**, 50-59 years **(985)** 60 years and above **(3,055)**.

A total of **481** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,296** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **24** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **12** of whom are on ventilatory support and **12** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **161** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **158** of them in the general wards. **3** patients are in the High Dependency Units (HDU).
