**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021, a total of **3,935,671** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **2,988,128** were

partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **947,543**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **31.7%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **3.5%**.

The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**. The following county figures represent those partially vaccinated in respective counties and percentage of the population in that area as follows;

On the other hand, for the second dose a total of **947,543** persons have so far been fully vaccinated out of the targeted **27,246,033** for this phase. In terms of Country distribution was as follows;

On the Covid-19 situation today **189** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **6,367** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.0%**. From the cases **182** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **99** females while **90** are males. The youngest is a **two-year-old child** while the oldest is **90** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **250,380** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,581,391**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **30**, Trans Nzoia **19**, Kisii **16**, Nakuru **15**, Garissa **10**, Elgeyo Marakwet **9**, Kericho **9**, Laikipia **8**, Kiambu **8**, Kitui **6**, Mombasa **6**, Machakos **5**, Baringo **5**, Kakamega **4**, Homa Bay **3**, Kirinyaga **3**, Murang'a **3**, Narok **3**, Embu **2**, Isiolo **2**, Nyandarua **2**, Marsabit **2**, Taita Taveta **2**,

Turkana **2**, West Pokot **2**, Migori **1**, Nandi **1**, Makueni **1**, Nyeri **1**, Uasin Gishu **1**, Vihiga **1**, Samburu **1**, Lamu **1**, Tana River **1**, Kwale **1**, Busia **1**, Kajiado **1** and Kisumu **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**4**), 10-19 years (**5**), 20-29 years (**33**), 30-39 (**42**), 40-49 (**29**), 50-59 (**35**), 60 years and above (**41**).

Today **207** patients have recovered from the disease with **117** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **90** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **243,064** of whom **196,519** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **46,545** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **9** patients have succumbed to the disease, all of them being late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the

month of September 2021. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,150**. Our sincere condolences to the family and friends of those who have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 **(0)**, 30-39 years **(0)**, 40-49 years **(0)**, 50-59 years **(2)**, 60 years and above **(7)**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(57)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(139)**, 30-39 years **(374)**, 40-49 years **(596)**, 50-59 years **(969)** 60 years and above **(2,977)**.

A total of **894** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,961** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **51** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **31** of whom are on ventilatory support and **19** on supplemental oxygen. **One** patient is under observation.

Another **302** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **289** of them in general wards and **13** in High Dependency Units (HDU).
