UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- **10,704,690**
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered Six million, three hundred and Seventy-five thousand, seven hundred and eighty-seven (**6,375,787**). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million, nine hundred and eighty-one thousand, nine hundred and two (**3,981,902**), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) two million, three hundred and ninety-three thousand, eight hundred and eighty-five persons (**2,393,885**) as at 19th, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday (Friday) is **64,038** compared to the previous day (Thursday) at **66,051**, out of the total vaccinated **18,867** received Dose 1, while **45,171** received Dose 2 and JJ vaccine.

Table 4 above and figure 1.1 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 24.6 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 20.2, Kiambu 14.9, Taita Taveta and Laikipia 12.0. Nyandarua 11.2, Uasin Gishu 10.6 and Muranga 10.3 and Kirinyaga 10.0. While Garissa, Wajir, Tana River, Turkana, West Pokot, Mandera and Marsabit with less than 2% of the population fully vaccinated

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county

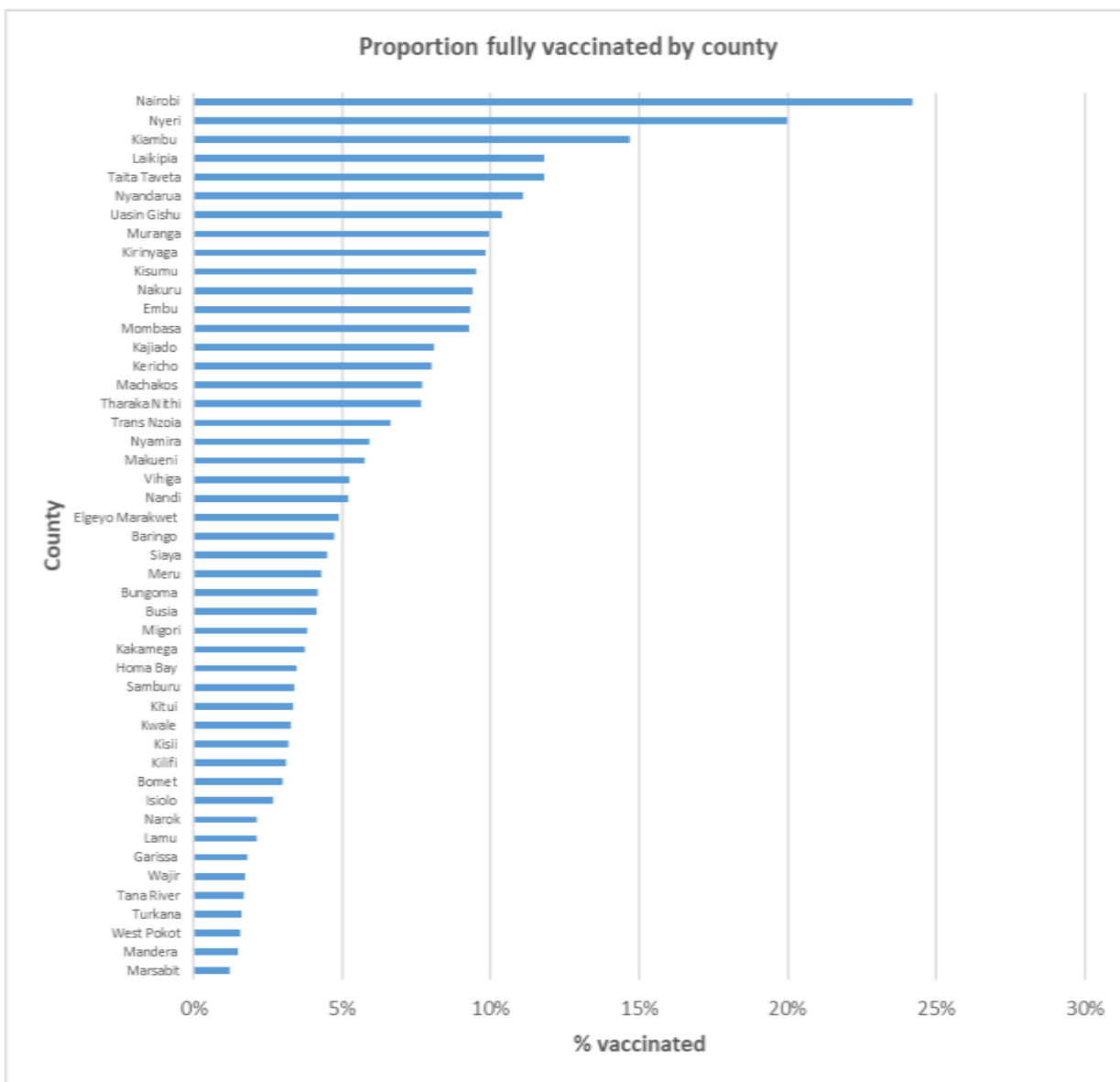

Table 7 above shows the proportion of the above 18 years' population who have received the first Dose (Dose 1) of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi county with 35.7% followed by Nyeri at 31.3, Kirinyaga at 23.4, Laikipia 23.4, Kiambu 21.7 and Muranga at 20.9, Marsabit and Wajir being the least with 1.5, Mandera 1.9 of the population received dose 1 vaccination.

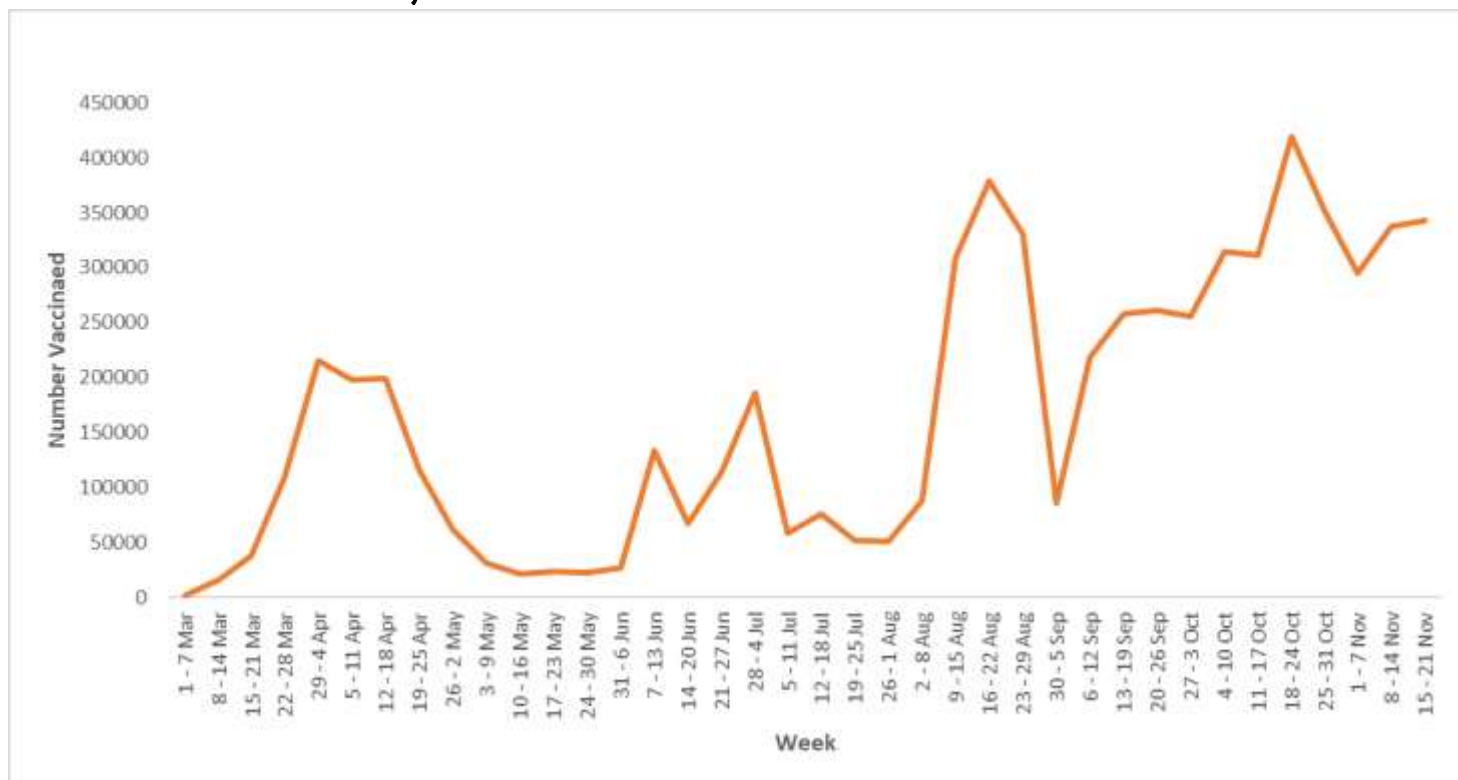


Table 8 shows the weekly trend of COVID- 19 doses administered starting from the start of the vaccination exercise to date (first week of March 2021 to week three of November 2021)
