PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of November 13th 2021, a total of **5,990,974** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,884,449**

were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **2,106,525**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **50.7%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **7.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is on the lead with **22.3%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri County at **19.2%**, Kiambu **12.7%**, Taita Taveta **10.5%**, Nyandarua **10.3%** and Laikipia **10.0%**.

The table below shows the proportion of the above 18 years who have received the first Dose of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi county is on the lead with **35.2%** followed by Nyeri at **30.7%**, Kirinyaga at **23.1%**, Laikipia **22.5%**, Kiambu **21.3%** and

Muranga at **20.4%**. Marsabit County is the least at **1.4%** followed by Wajir **1.5%** and Mandera at **1.9%** of the population to have received the first dose of the vaccination.

On the Covid-19 situation today **21** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,709** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.8%**. From the cases **20** are Kenyans and **one** foreigner. **14** males and **7** are females. The youngest is an **11-year-old child** while the oldest is **77** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **254,297** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,770,062**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **7**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Kiambu **3**, Migori **2**, West Pokot **2**, Kitui **1**, Mombasa **1**, Nakuru **1** and Bungoma **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(7)**, 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Today **12** patients have recovered from the disease with **10** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **2** are from health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **247,645** of whom **200,054** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,591** are from various health facilities countrywide.

There is no death reported today. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,316**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(385)**, 40-49 years **(616)**, 50-59 years **(994)** 60 years and above **(3,082)**.

A total of **391** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,031** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **26** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **12** of whom are on ventilatory support and **14** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **112** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **110** of them are in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
