PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of November 18th 2021, a total of **6,311,749** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,963,035**

were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **2,348,714**. The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **55.4%**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **8.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**. Total Vaccines received to date are **10,704, 690**.

The table below shows the total County cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County is in the lead with **24.2%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county at **20.0%**, Kiambu **14.7%**, Taita Taveta and Laikipia **11.8%**, Nyandarua **11.1%**, Uasin Gishu **10.4%** and Muranga **10.0%**.

The table below shows the proportion of the above 18 years who have received the first Dose of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi county is in the lead with **35.6%** followed by Nyeri at **31.1%**, Kirinyaga at **23.4%**, Laikipia **23.2%**, Kiambu **21.6%** and

Muranga at **20.8%**. Marsabit and Wajir counties are the least with **1.5%** followed by Mandera with **1.9%** of the population having received dose 1 of the vaccination.

On the Covid-19 situation today **88** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **4,802** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.8%**. From the cases **82** are Kenyans while **six** are foreigners. **44** males and **44** are females. The youngest is a **six-year-old child** while the oldest is **86** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **254,629** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,790,474**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **17**, Siaya **16**, Kericho **14**, Nakuru **8**, Kakamega **5**, Kisii **5**, Turkana **3**, Nyeri **3**, Machakos **2**, Trans Nzoia **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, West Pokot **2**, Bomet **1**, Bungoma

1, Busia **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Garissa **1**, Kajiado **1**, Kiambu **1**, Murang'a **1** and Taita Taveta **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(23)**, 20-29 years **(12)**, 30-39 **(14)**, 40-49 **(8)**, 50-59 **(10)**, 60 years and above **(19)**.

Today **57** patients have recovered from the disease with **35** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **22** are from various health facilities countrywide. Total recoveries now stand at **247,874** of whom **200,195** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,679** are from various health facilities countrywide.

There is no death reported today. Therefore, the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,325**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(39)**, 20-29 **(142)**, 30-39 years **(386)**, 40-49 years **(616)**, 50-59 years **(996)** 60 years and above **(3,088)**

A total of **367** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **993** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **21** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **9** of whom are on ventilatory support and **12** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **118** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **116** of them are in the general wards. **Two** patients are in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
